### NEW HIRE DEMOGRAPHICS






In 2021, the PPD saw an increase of 1% in minority hiring. Due to COVID-19, the PPD only had one Police Recruit exam in 2021, which resulted in the hiring of 10 new officers in January 2022. 25% of projected new hires in 2022 are minorities.


#### RECRUITS

Protected Class currently makes up 33% of recruits with minorities making up 11%.


#### CADETS


While the PPDs Cadet program has seen a large decrease in its members, the PPD still strives to keep minorities involved. Minorites currently make up 50% of cadets.
