ACTION REQUESTED:

Communication from the City Manager and Corporation Counsel with a Request to DENY the SITE APPLICATION for a Class A (Tavern) Liquor License with On-Site Consumption and Retail Sale of Alcohol for EXOTIC VIBEZ, LLC, D/B/A EXOTIC VIBEZ, 2608 N. SHERIDAN ROAD, Contingent Upon the Issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy, with a Recommendation from the Liquor Commission to Deny. (Council District 2)

BACKGROUND: Victor Taylor, Owner, Exotic Vibez, LLC presented a Site Application for a Class A (Tavern) Liquor License, with a Subclass 2 (live entertainment) at 2608 N. Sheridan. The Liquor Commission voted unanimously to recommend denial of this request 4-0. Minutes of the Liquor Commission Meeting are attached.
