Communication from the City Manager and Corporation Counsel with a Request to APPROVE the SITE APPLICATION for a Class I (Assembly Hall/Stadium) Liquor License with the Retail Sale of Alcohol at the EXPOSITION GARDENS, INC., D/B/A EXPO GARDENS, 1601 W. NORTHMOOR ROAD, with a Recommendation from the Liquor Commission to Approve. (Council District 4)

BACKGROUND: Rob Murphy and Erica Abenroth, Executive Board Members, Exposition Gardens, Inc., presented a Site Application for a Class I (assembly hall/stadium) Liquor License, with a Subclass 7 (assembly halls) for 1601 W.
