

**ORDINANCE 17,528**

**AN ORDINANCE LEVYING THE TAXES FOR THE FISCAL  
YEAR 2018 FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES FOR THE  
CITY OF PEORIA, ILLINOIS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, ILLINOIS:**

**Section 1.** That there is hereby levied pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois upon all property within the City of Peoria, Illinois for the current fiscal year commencing on the first day of January, 2018 and ending on the thirty-first day of December, 2018 for all municipal purposes a direct tax sufficient to produce the sum of **\$28,478,081** in accordance with the powers granted to the City by authority of Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and not withstanding any rate as provided by statute pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code.

**Section 2.** That said sum of **\$28,478,081** being the amount budgeted which is to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year of the City of Peoria, Illinois for all municipal purposes including General Fund, Public Library Fund, Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund, FICA/Medicare Fund, Road and Bridge Fund, the Police Pension Fund, and the Firemen's Pension Fund as budgeted for the current fiscal year by the annual city budget for the year 2018 adopted by the City Council of the City of Peoria at the legally convened meeting of November 7, 2017 and the same is hereby levied upon all taxable property in the City of Peoria subject to taxation for the current year. The specific amounts as levied for the various funds heretofore named being included herein by being placed in separate columns under the heading "Amount to be Included in Tax Levy" which appears over same being as follows:

**Section 3.** The City Clerk of the City of Peoria, Illinois, is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the County Clerk of the County of Peoria, Illinois, and the said County Clerk is hereby requested and directed to extend said tax in the manner provided by law.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval according to law.

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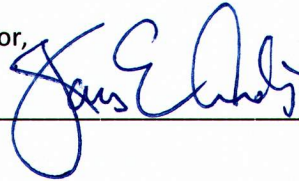
