Resolution WAIVING the Bidding Requirements for an additional seven (7) SUVs for an Amount not to exceed \$255,490.00

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria (City) recognizes the need to procure equipment to provide necessary services to the community; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council, accepted the receipt of a grant and associated budget amendment in the amount of \$3,068,000 from the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority (ICJIA) for implementation of a co-response policing model; and,

WHEREAS, Section 10-100 of the City Code requires all purchases in excess of \$15,000.00 be awarded as part of competitive bidding process, except by a two-thirds vote of all councilmen actually voting to direct the City Manager or Comptroller to enter into such purchase or contract without formal bidding; and,

WHEREAS, the Staff has attempted formal bidding for the award of nine (9) vehicles for the Peoria Police Departments co-response model and have only been able to award two (2);

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Peoria as follows:

- Section 1. The City Council waive formal bidding for the provision of the purchase of seven (7) additional vehicles.
- Section 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager or his designee to purchase seven (7) additional vehicles for an amount not to exceed \$255,490.00
- Section 3. This Resolution shall be in effect immediately from and after its passage and approval.
