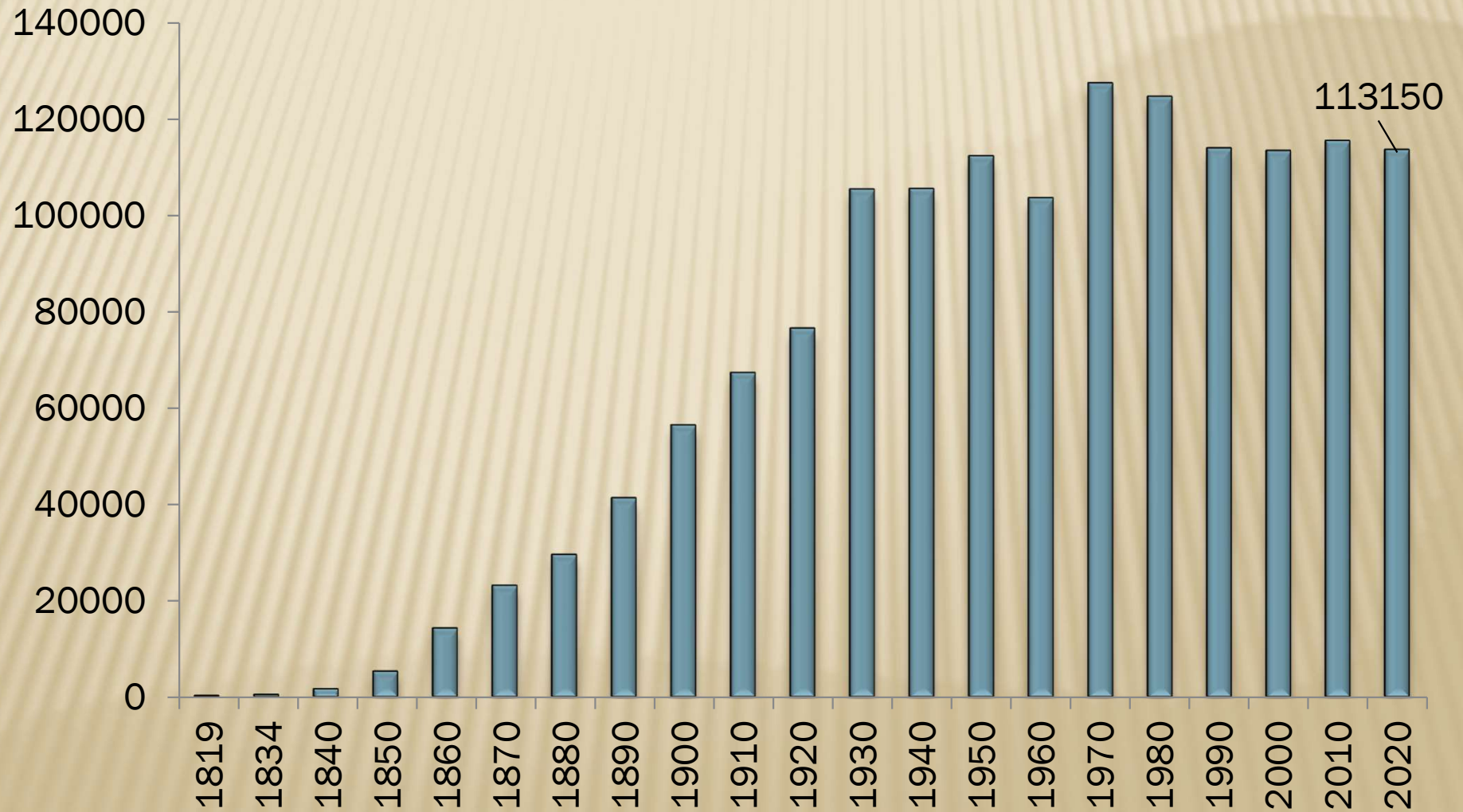

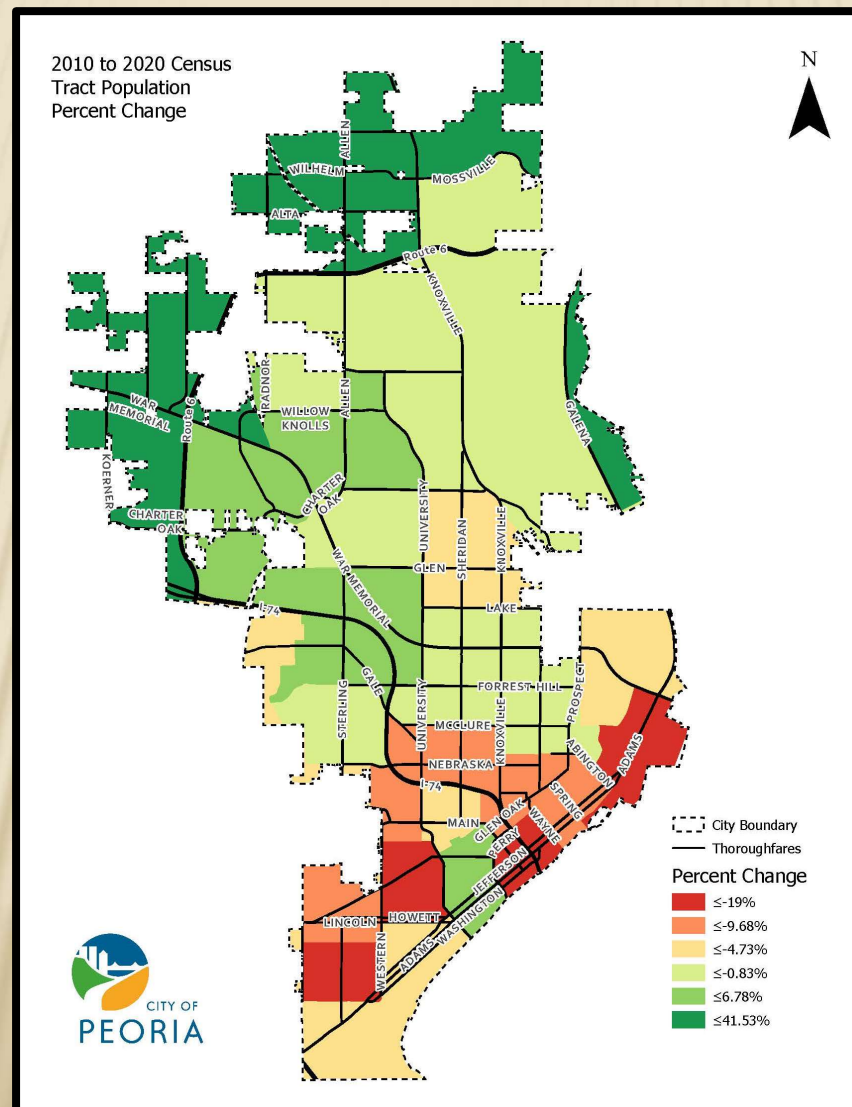
- × Boundary & Annexation Survey (BAS)

- × Complete Count Committee
 - + Chaired by Councilman Ruckriegel
- × Self-Response Cumulative Rate
 - + 68.3% self-response rate in Peoria vs 67% nationally
- × Self-Response Internet Rate
 - + 55% self-response rate in Peoria vs 53.5% nationally

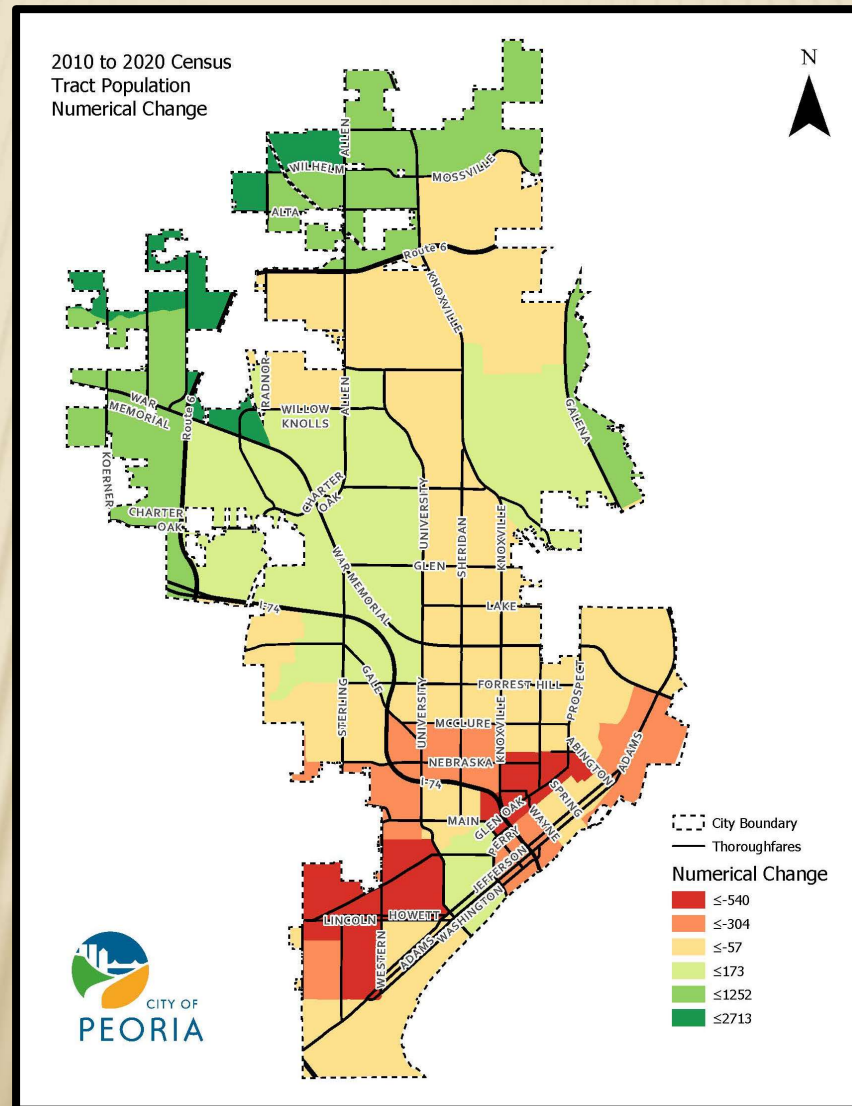
Total City Population



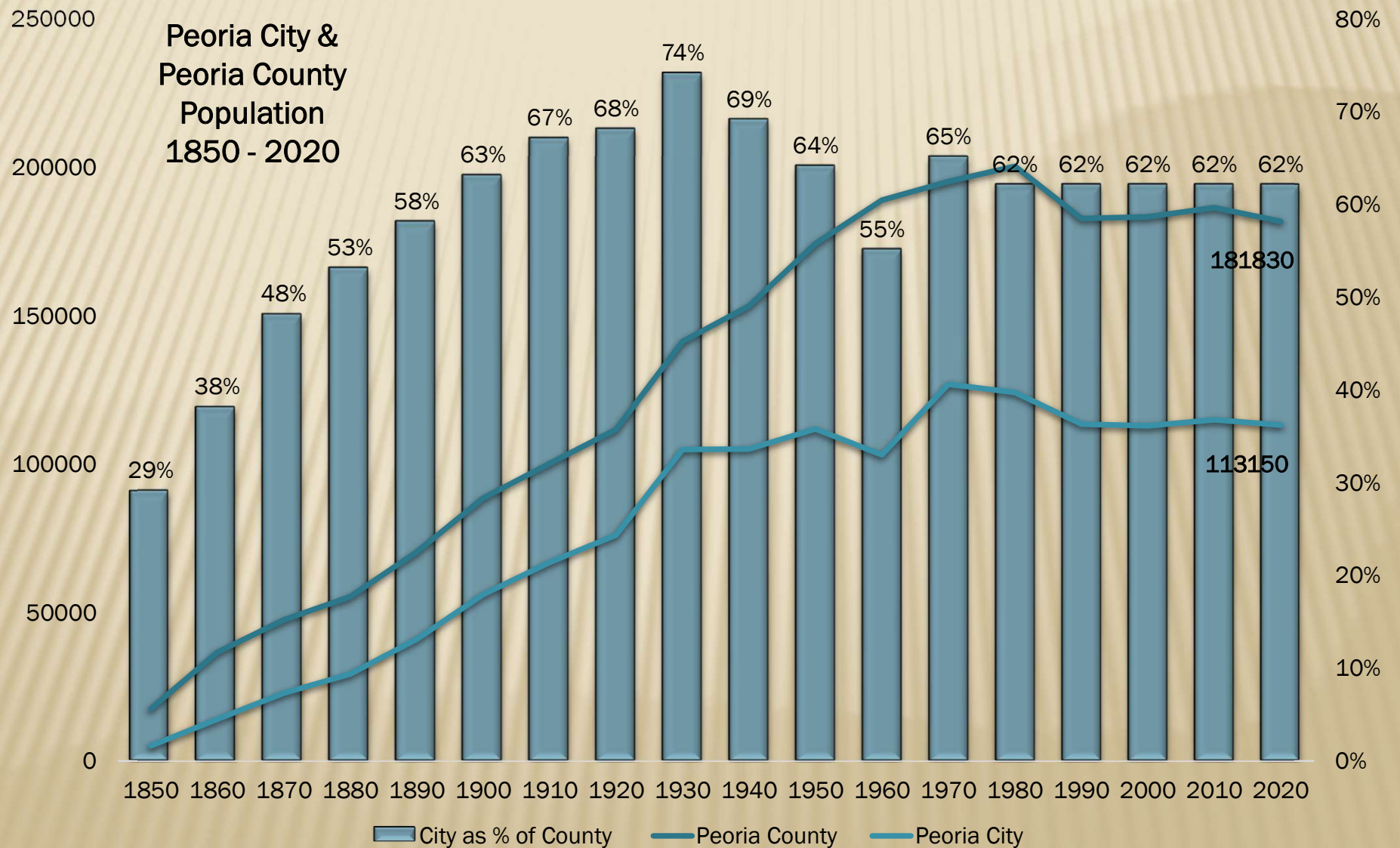
POPULATION PERCENT CHANGE 2010 - 2020



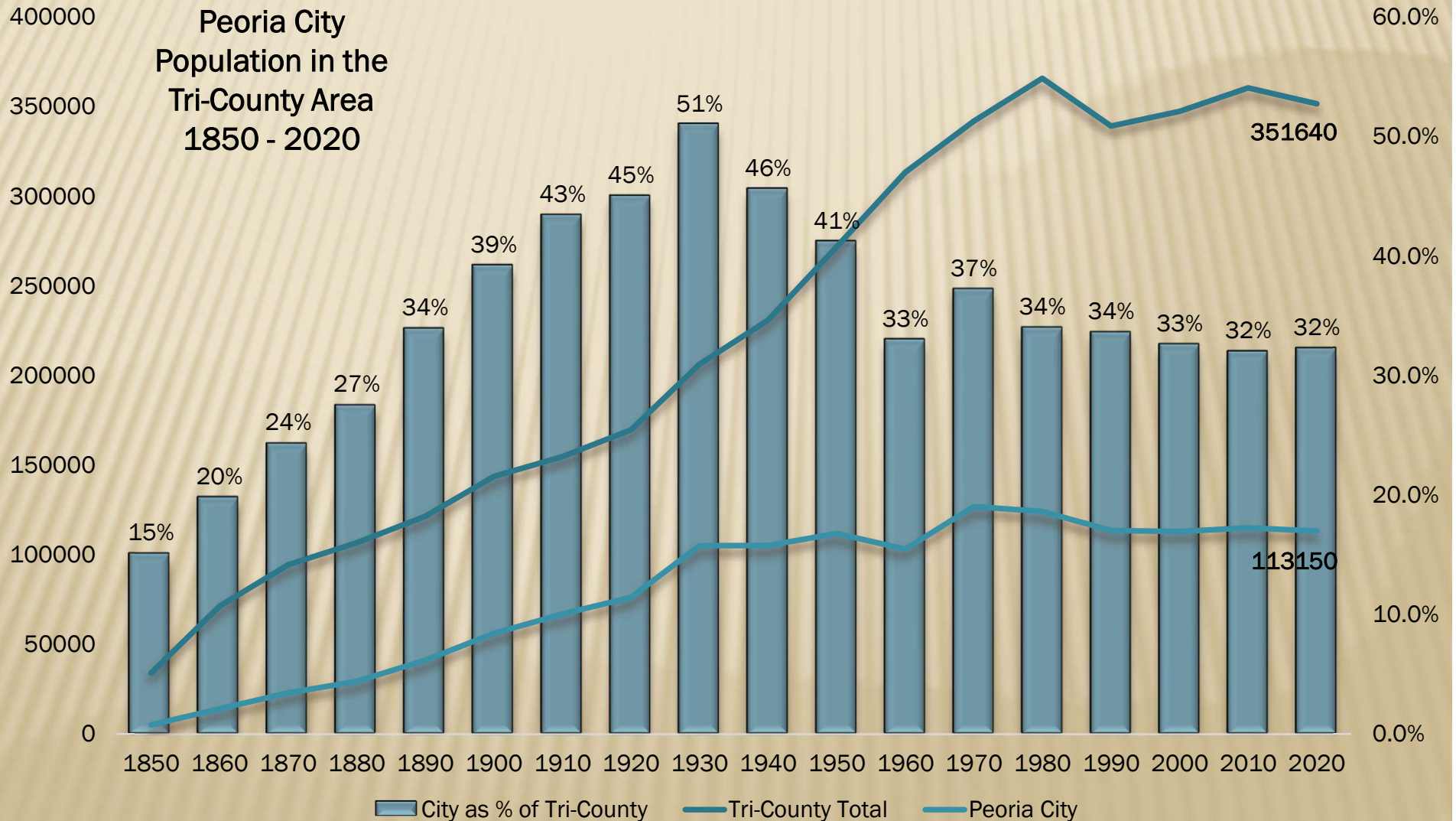
POPULATION NUMERIC CHANGE 2010 - 2020

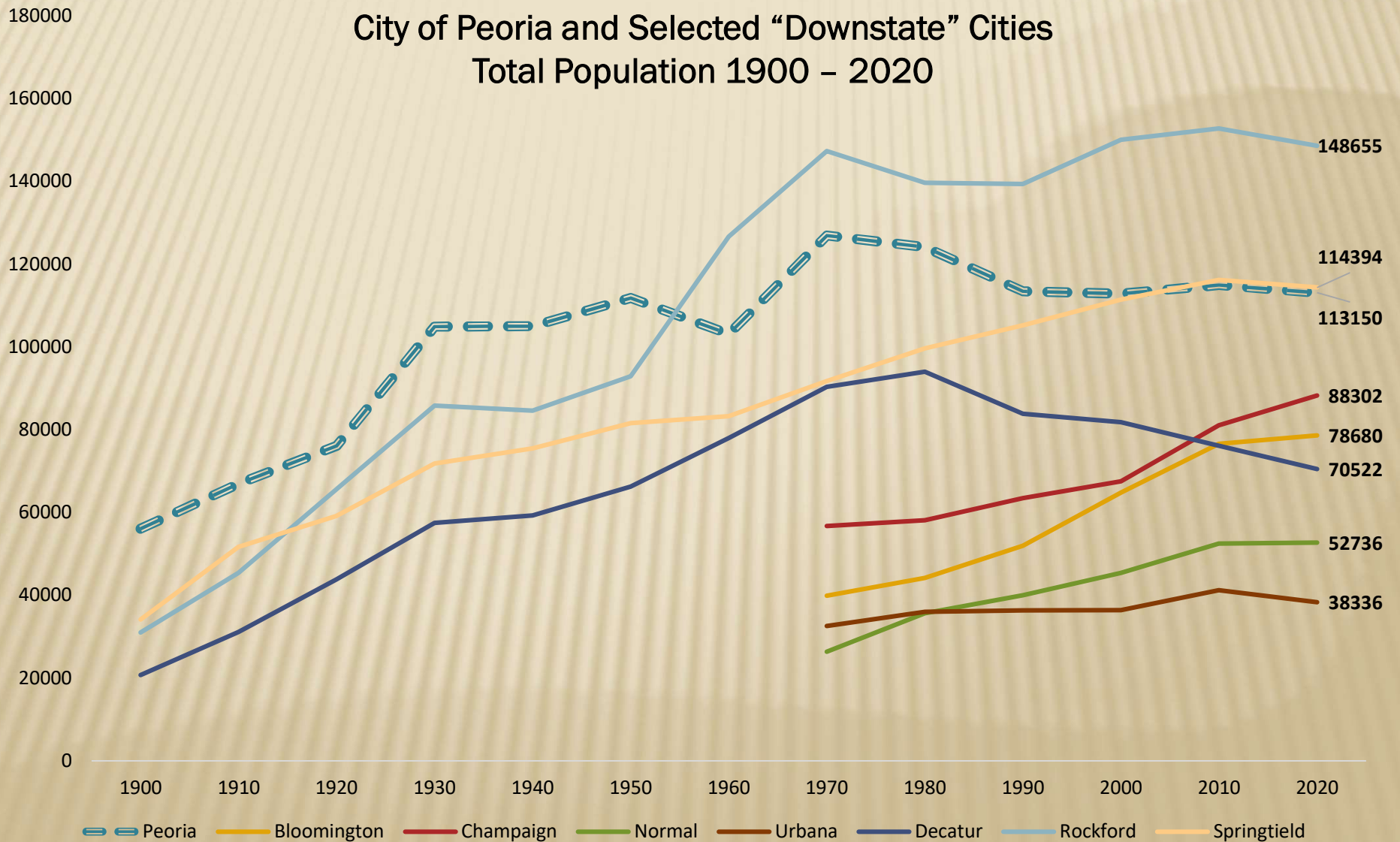


PEORIA IN THE TRI-COUNTY AREA



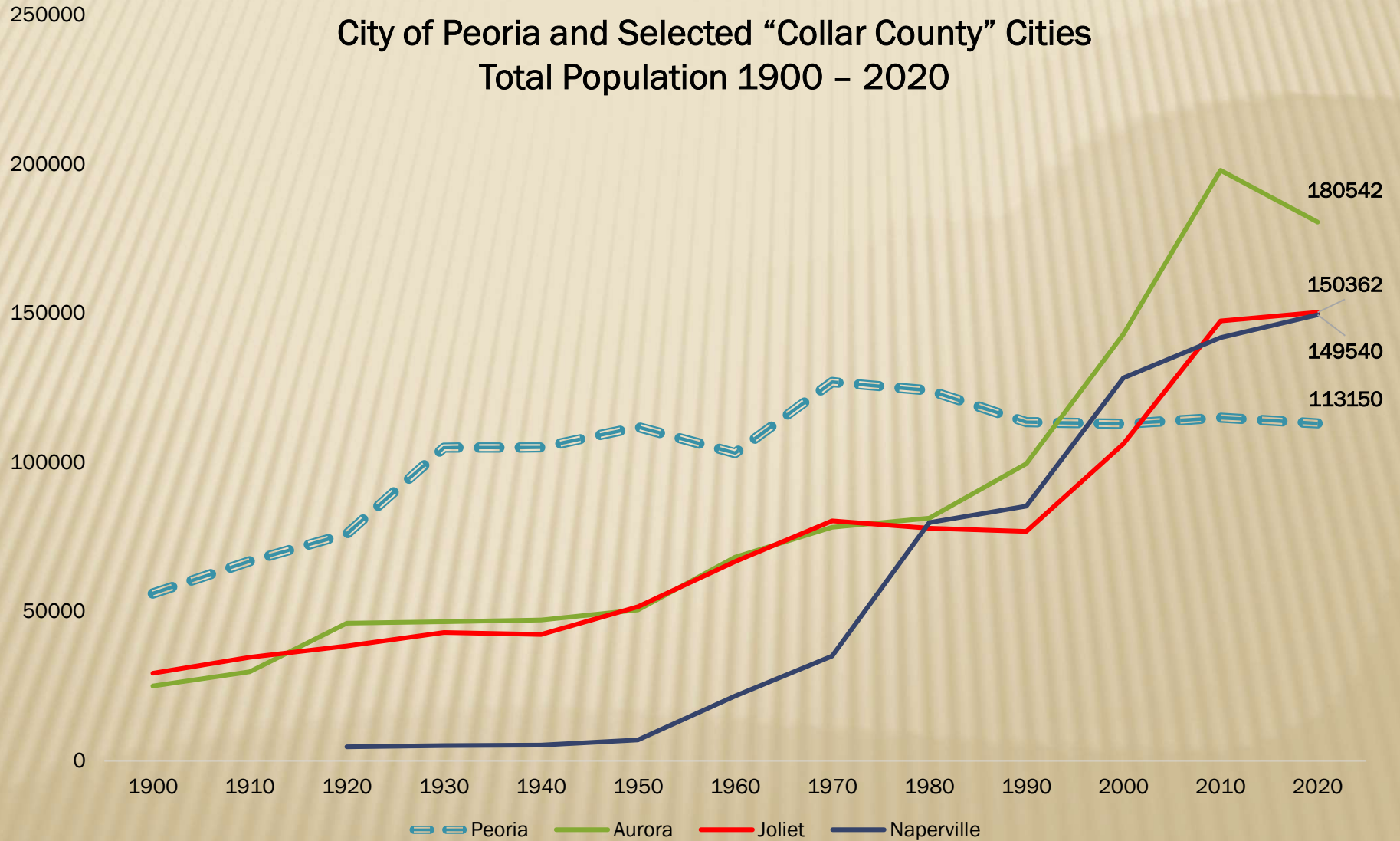

Total Population 1900 - 2020



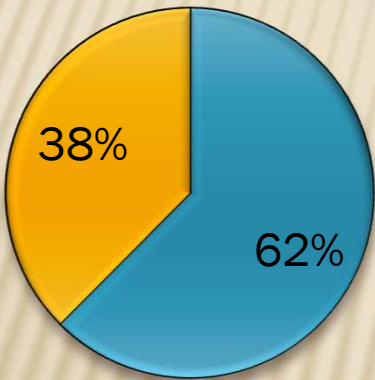
COLLAR COUNTY CITIES

Total Population 1900 - 2020

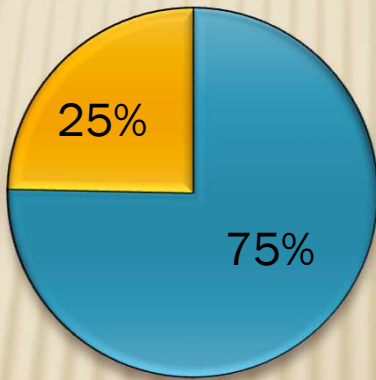

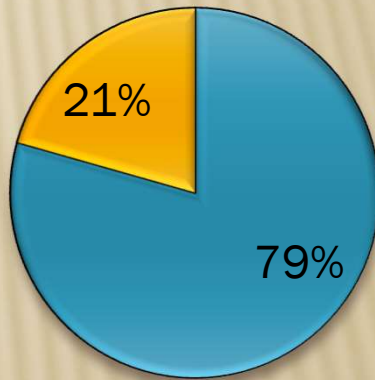

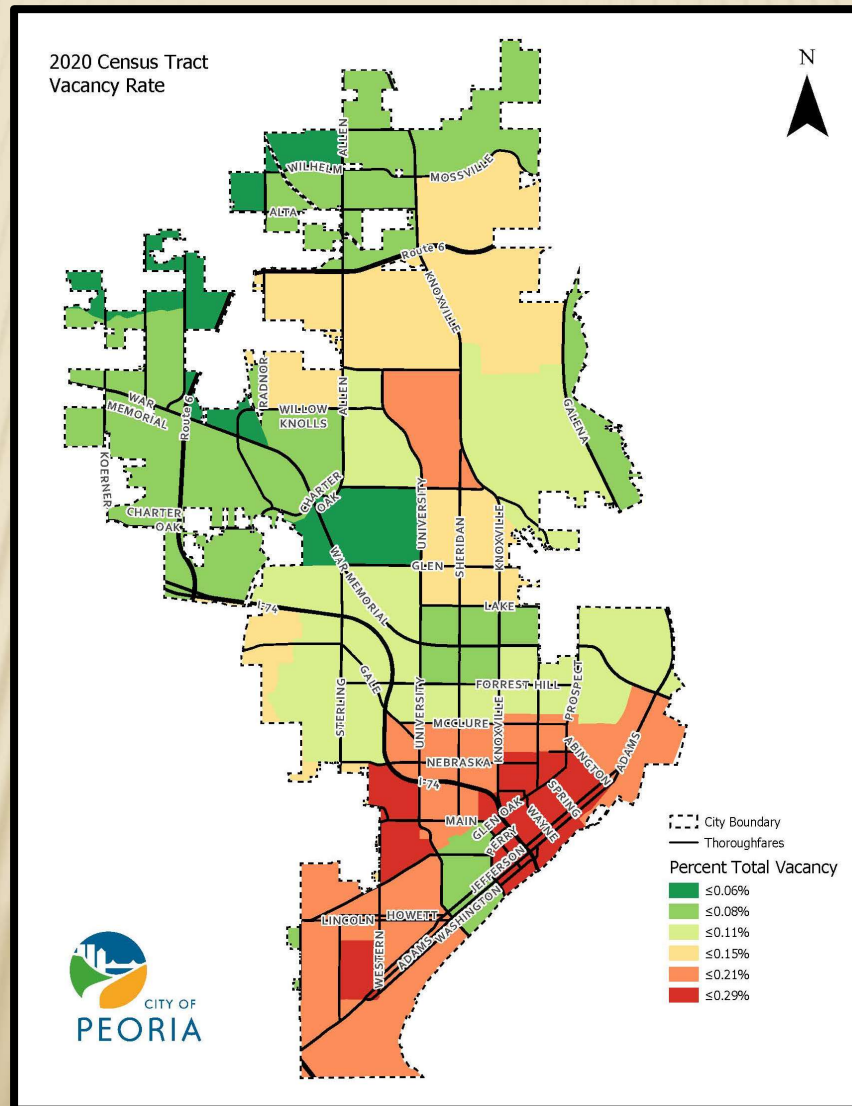

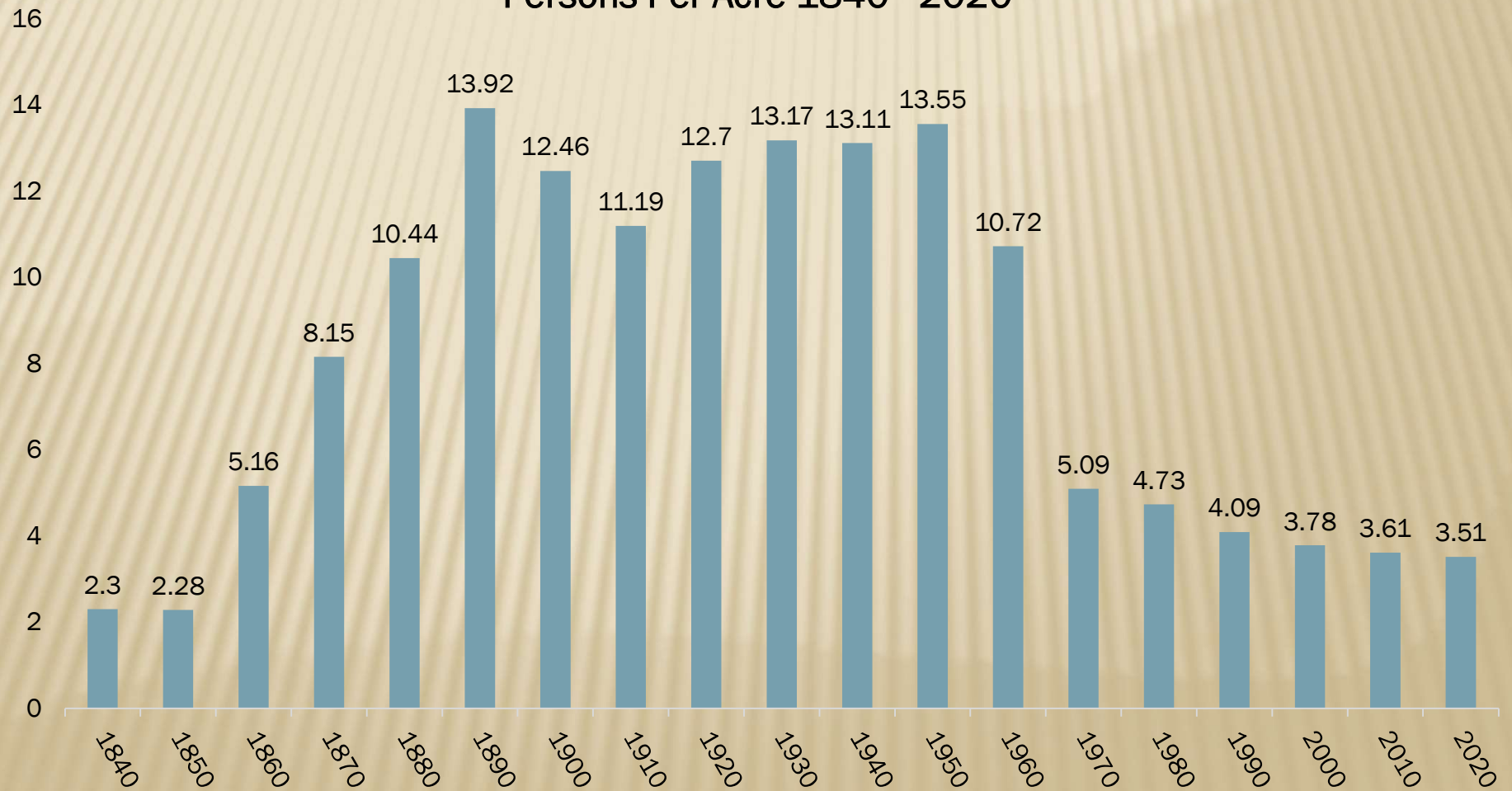

HOUSING VACANCY 2020

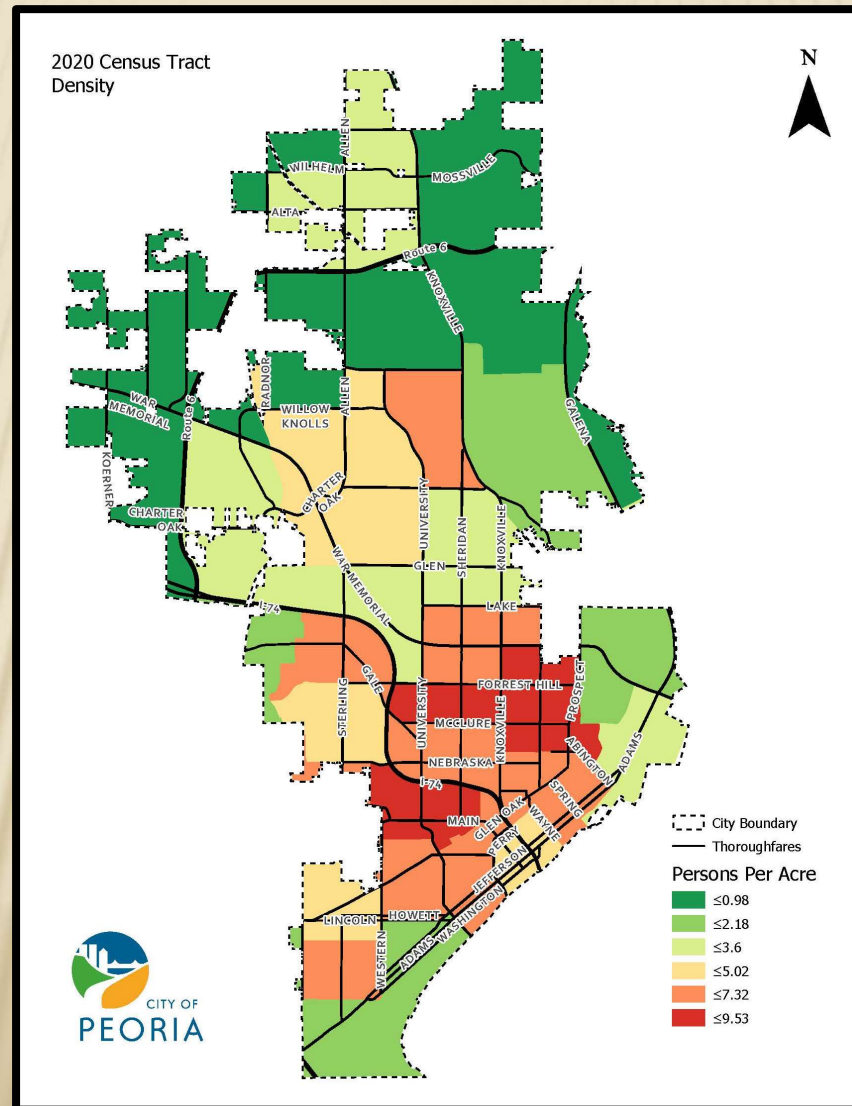


HISTORIC POPULATION DENSITY

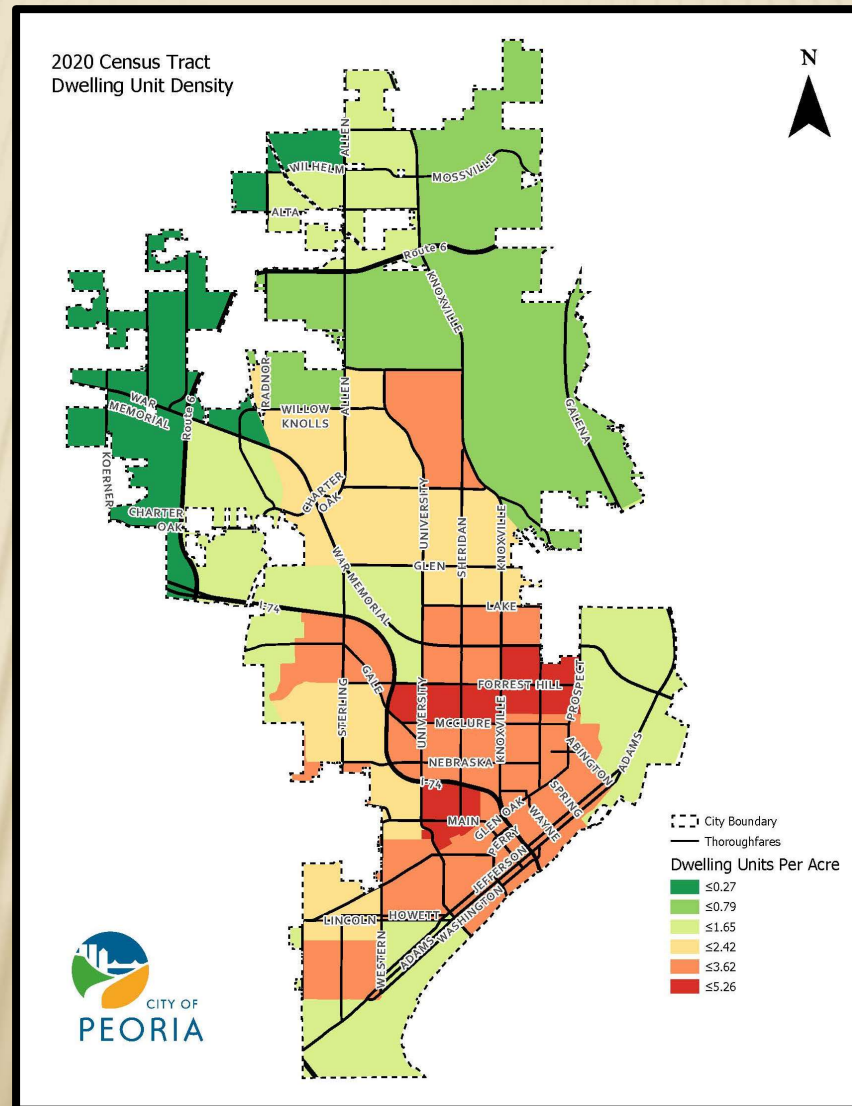
Peoria Population Density
Persons Per Acre 1840 - 2020



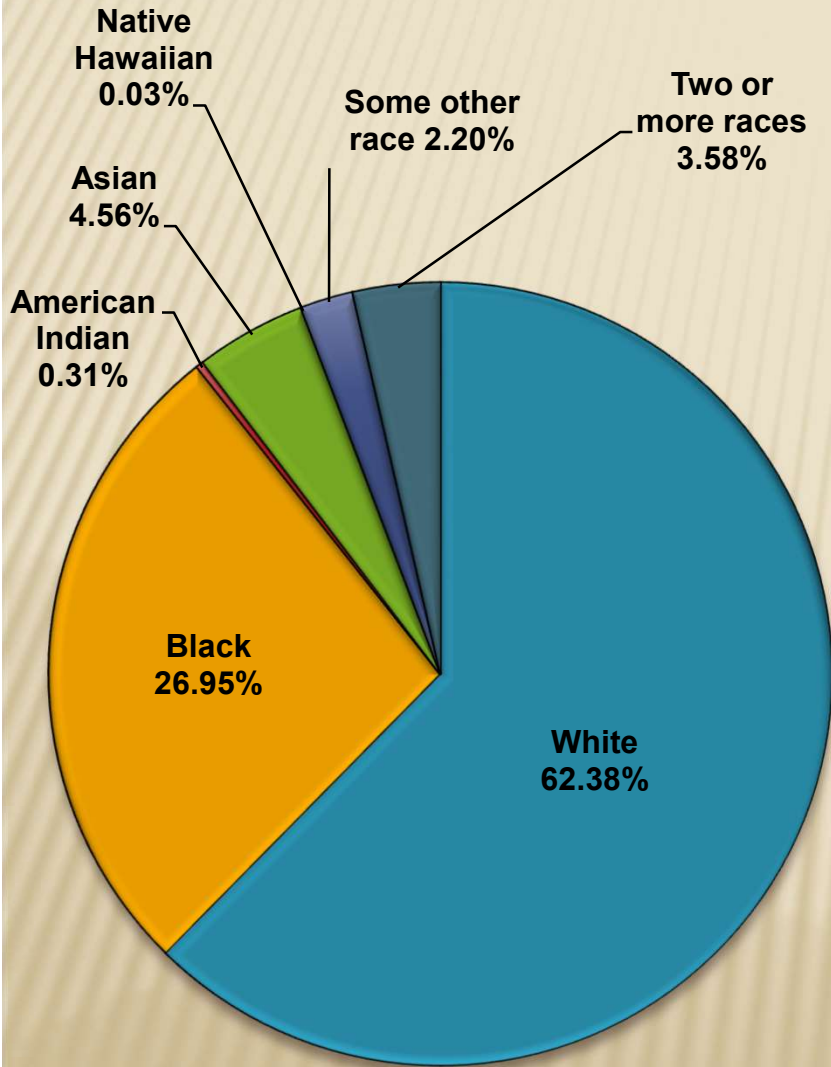
POPULATION DENSITY 2020



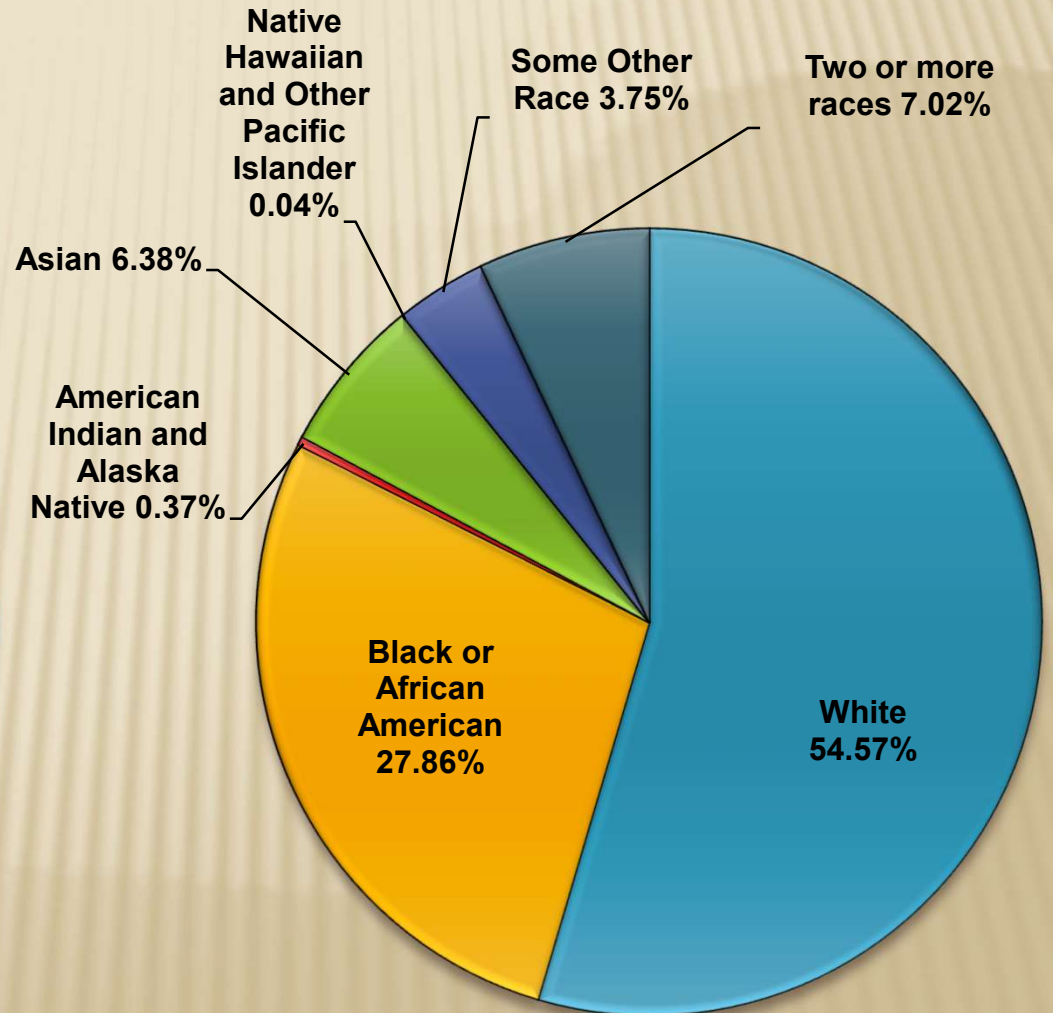
DWELLING UNIT DENSITY 2020



RACIAL DISTRIBUTION 2010 - 2020

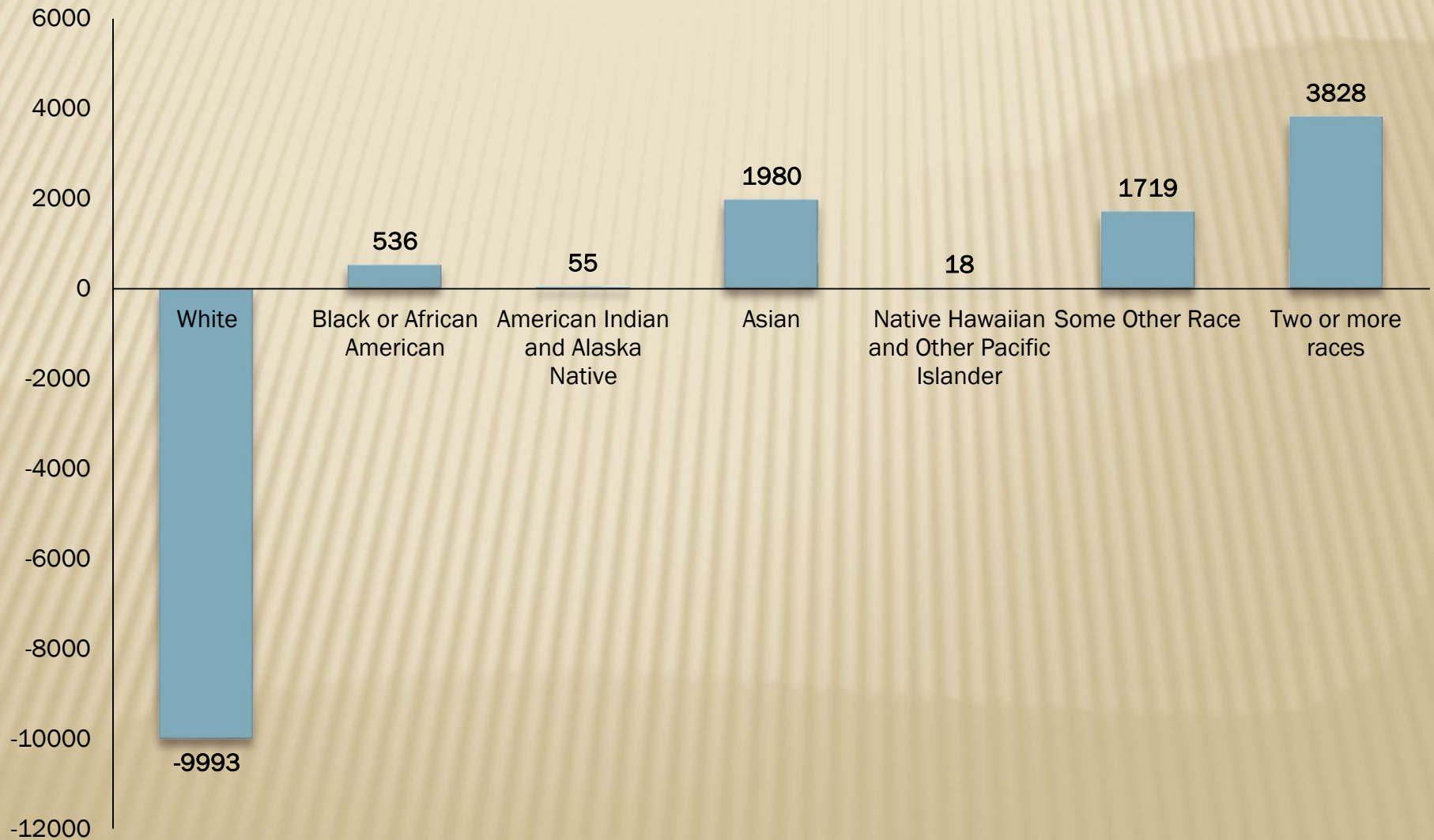

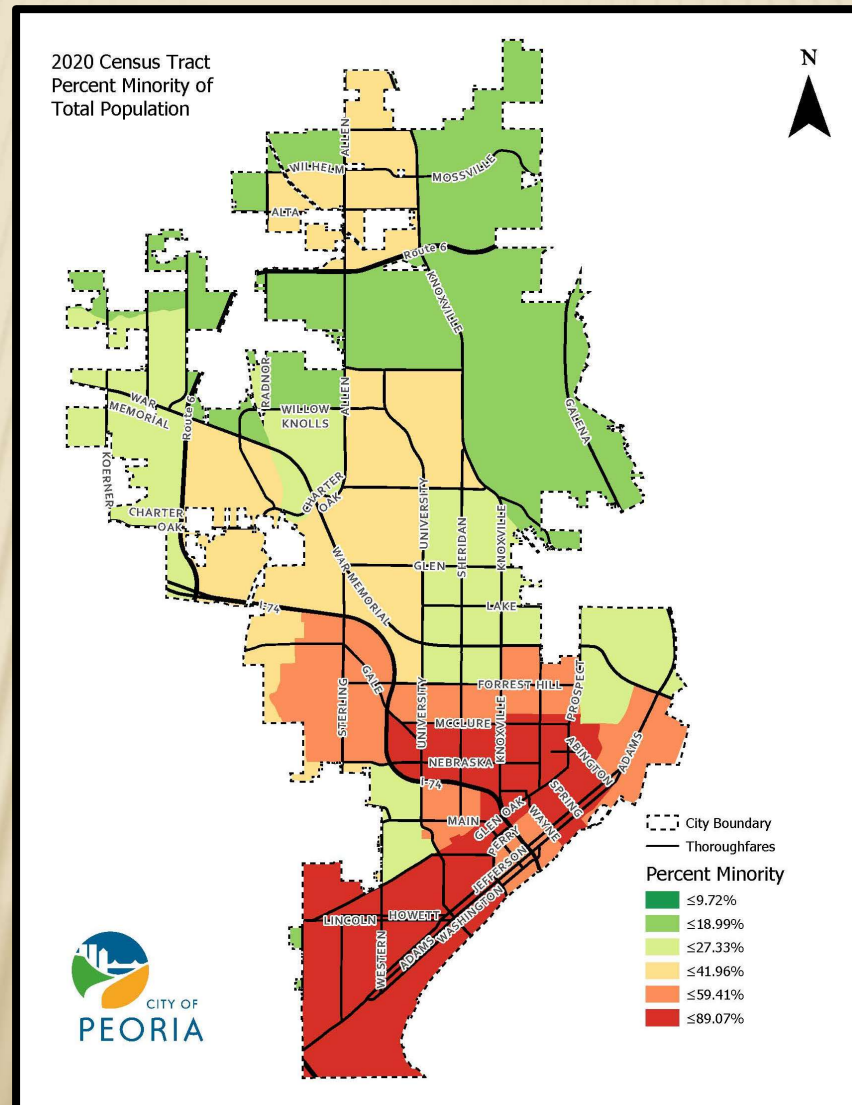

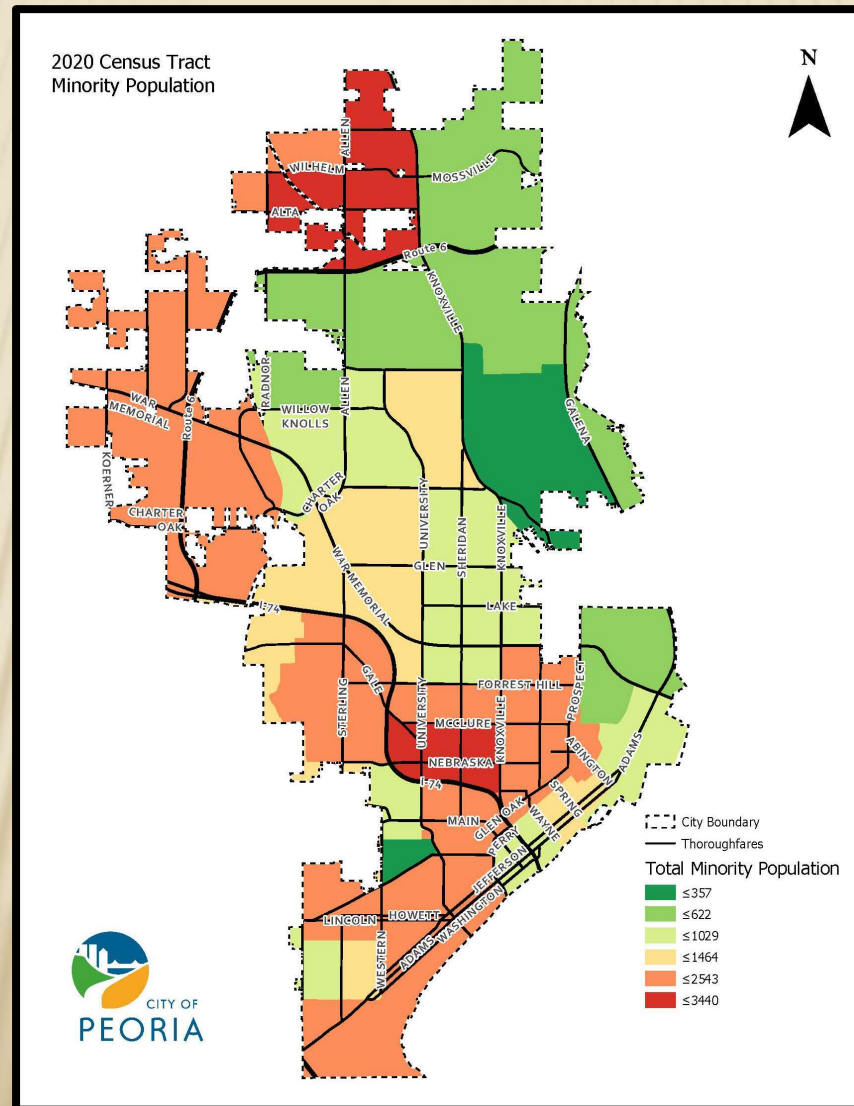
CHANGE IN RACIAL COMPOSITION 2020

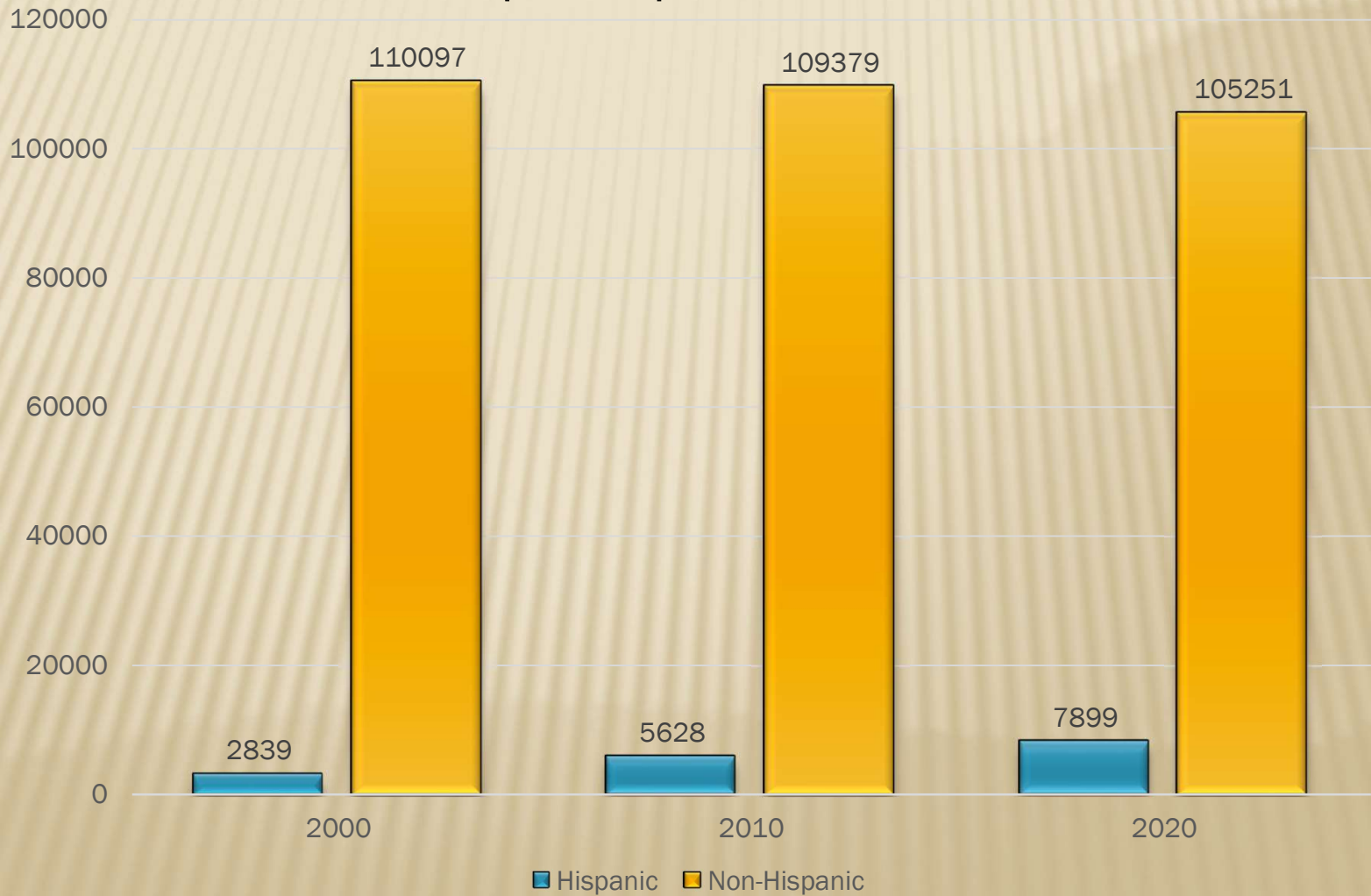


RACIAL DISTRIBUTION 2020

Total Hispanic Population 2000 - 2020

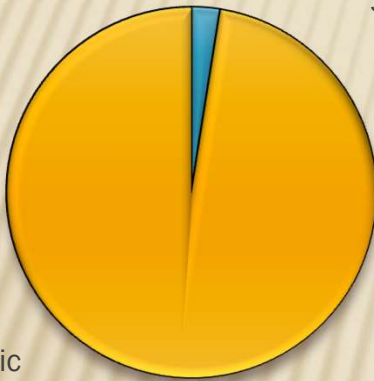

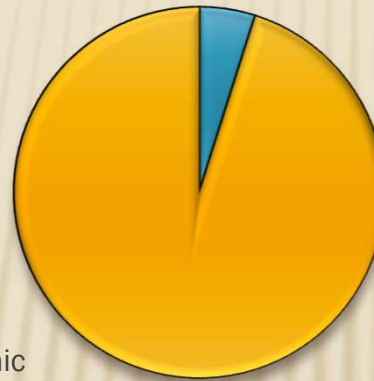

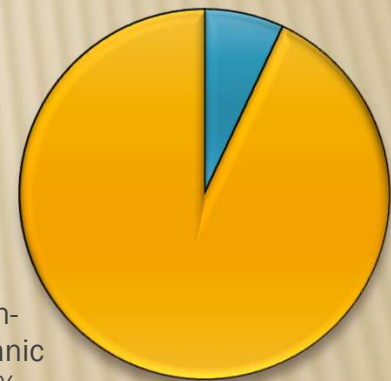
