Fadi Atrash, Owner, and Yousef Saleh, Manager, Royal Hookah Lounge, presented a Site Application for a Class A (tavern) Liquor License at 2027 W. Farmington Road, Unit A.

In discussion with Chairman Cassidy, Mr. Saleh said in order to obtain additional business, he said they wanted to add the sale of alcohol to an existing hookah lounge. He said their current hours of operation were from 5:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. on weekdays and from 5:00 p.m. to 3:00 a.m. on weekends.

During more discussion, Mr. Saleh said they planned to have coolers for the beer and wine. He said initially, there wouldn't be a bar in the establishment.

Commissioner Miller expressed his concerns in regards to the Police Department's comments and the issues that had taken place at other establishments operated by the owner.

In response to Commissioner Miller's concerns, Mr. Saleh said he would be managing the establishment and he said he would be making sure patrons were over the legal age. He said currently 18 years of age was the age limit.

Liquor Investigator Slavens said the Police Department's comments spoke for itself. He mentioned numerous issues and complaints in relation to establishments that were run by the owner. He asked that the Commission take into consideration the applicant's track record while making the decision to add the sale of alcohol to the proposed site.

Chairman Cassidy commented for the record that he always felt that there was a fine line between the Commission's role on site approval vs. whether if any particular individual should get the license once the site was approved. He said in this case, the applicant did not have a business plan or a bar set up. He went on to say that they weren't proposing any reconstruction of the establishment and they only wanted to put in a cooler to serve beer and wine to their customers. He said for those reasons, he would not be supporting the application.

After more comments, Mr. Saleh said their main reason for wanting to add the sale of alcohol was because they wanted to add slot machines.

Hearing no more questions, Chairman Cassidy called for the motion.

Commissioner Kelsey moved to recommend <u>denial</u> of the Site Application for a Class A (tavern) Liquor License at 2027 W. Farmington Road, Unit A, based on the Police Department's comments; seconded by Commissioner O'Brien.





A site approval application has been received from Hooka Café, Inc., d/b/a Hooka Café Inc., 2027 W. Farmington Rd., Peoria, Illinois. Hooka Café Inc. is requesting site approval for a Class A liquor license which would allow the applicant to operate a tavern with full bar service.

Officer Kevin Slavens visited the site which sits across the street from Bradley Park and is part of a small commercial strip along Farmington Road and Park Street. Neighboring businesses include, a few restaurants, two other taverns, a gas station and a liquor store. There are no nearby residences to this location and the site does currently hold a tobacco license at this location.

The owner / operator of the *Royal Hooka Café* at 2027 W. Farmington Rd., is Mr. Fadi Atrash. Mr. Atrash has owned numerous Peoria businesses over the last several years and currently owns at least two other convenient stores in Peoria that hold tobacco licenses. Mr. Atrash's stores have a well-documented history and are notorious for illegally selling tobacco products to minors and have received at least *seven* municipal ordinance violations from the Peoria Police Department since 2012. Mr. Atrash has personally sold and has been cited by the Peoria Police Department on January 30, 2012 at M & G Food Mart, 640 W. Main St. and on May, 17th, 2015 at 1830 N. Sheridan Rd. for the sale of cigarette products to a minor (PPD #12-2566 and #15-9354).

On October 9th, 2015 Peoria Police responded to the Royal Hooka Café on a male charging admission at the front door of the business. During this investigation officers discovered that a private party was being held on the premises where alcoholic beverages were being illegally served and consumed on this site. Peoria Police Officers issued a municipal ordinance violation for illegally operating a bottle club to the manager of the business, who was only 18 years of age at the time. Former Peoria Police Department Liquor Investigator Scott Jordan conducted a follow up investigation of this incident. Mr. Atrash informed Officer Jordan that he allowed a promoter to host an event at his business which he knew would include the playing of music, but stated that he was unware that alcoholic beverages were going to be served and consumed on the premises. Mr. Atrash was cited during this investigation and issued a municipal ordinance violation by Officer Jordan for operating without a license on October 12th, 2015 (PPD #15-20775).

Furthermore, the *Greater Peoria Area Crime Stoppers* has received information that was forwarded to the Peoria Police Department that the Nebraska Food Mart, which is owned and operated by Mr. Atrash, was selling illegal synthetic cannabinoids, also known as "K-2" and "Spice". The sale of synthetic cannabinoids is a felony under the Illinois Complied Statutes as well as a federal crime under section 21 of the United States Code regarding drug related offenses. Peoria Police Officer Doug Burgess, the former *Greater Peoria Area Crime Stoppers'* liaison officer, had received additional anonymous phone calls in 2015 and 2016 regarding the sale of "K-2" from Mr. Atrash's store. More importantly, these complaints and allegations have been corroborated and substantiated by officers of the Peoria Police Department and other law enforcement agencies.

Historically, liquor establishments have led to an increase in crime, traffic, noise, litter and similar quality of life issues resulting in a general overall decline of a neighborhood. The Peoria Police Department does not believe that there is a community desire, nor economic need, for another bar in this neighborhood as there are seven other taverns within approximately one half mile from this site. Also, the proximity of this site to Bradley Park is a concern as the park routinely host family orientated events and several youth related activities, which also include college softball throughout the year.

Finally, this site resides in an established commercial area and known college bar district with numerous other alike businesses. Site approvals, being location specific and not owner specific, have proven extremely difficult to revoke once approved. In this case, the Peoria Police Department believes that the granting of site approval is disconcerting as the applicant has a disreputable history of illegally selling tobacco products to minors and unlawfully selling of synthetic cannabinoids. The Peoria Police Department understandably has grave concerns that these illicit business practices would only continue with far greater repercussions with the selling and serving of alcoholic beverages.

The Peoria Police Department recommends denial of this site approval application.
