Sam Zabek, Attorney, and Alecia Collins, Owner, presented a Site Application for a Class A (tavern) Liquor License, with a Subclass 1A (2:00 a.m. closing hours) and a Subclass 2 (live entertainment) at 1801-03 SW Adams.

Chairman Miller gave a brief overview of the previous actions in regards to the subject property. He said initially, the Police Dept. had recommended approval of the Site Application, but after further research they changed their recommendation to denial.

In discussion with Chairman Miller in regards to the difference between this request and the previous one, Attorney Zabek reported that although the applicant was denied Site Approval, in good faith she had paved the parking lot to add additional parking for the establishment to accommodate previous concerns. He said this would help alleviate the problem mentioned by the neighboring property owner in regards to patrons of this establishment parking in his adjacent parking lot. He explained the role of the Commission and he said Site Approval was to ensure that the site was appropriate for the retail sale of alcohol. He said it was not based on an operator or even if whether past operators had been appropriate for the site. He said the ordinance does allow for the Commission and the City Council to consider if an establishment would be injurious to the environment. He said he did not feel that there had been any concerns with the current applicant with regard to how she would operate the business. He said all of the information he read pertained to previous owners and incidents that happened at the location from previous operators. He said those things had absolutely no bearings on the subject application. He mentioned comments from the letters from the Peoria Police Dept. and he agreed that the location had been a tavern since 1961. He went on to say that there were six other taverns in the neighborhood. He said there was nothing that would indicate this request would be detrimental to nearby businesses. He also submitted that the petition summary that was submitted by Mr. Serafin outlined a number of business owners, but he said no one else spoke except himself. He said Mr. Serafin had legitimate concerns based on previous owners and operations at this site. He then pointed out that according to the Police Department's letter, none of the neighborhood residents had expressed any concerns and he said they were who would normally be most concerned. He went on to say that he did not see any reasons how this application would cause those same concerns. He suggested that the Commission recommend approval.

In more discussion, Chairman Miller agreed with Attorney Zabek's description of the Commission's role. He said he would like to possibly see an approval with a Plan of Operation, which spelled out what the City and the neighboring community expected of this establishment.

In response to Chairman Miller's comments, Attorney Zabek said he had previously mentioned a Plan of Operation to his client and he said she indicated that she would not be objectionable to having one.

Pierre Serafin, Neighboring Business Owner, spoke in opposition of the Site Application. He said he was not the adversary and he said he was just trying to be proactive. He said it was nice that the applicant added seven more parking spots, but he said based on her previous projections, up to 70 people could

patronize this establishment. He said this would mean more cars would be parked up and down the streets in this area. He said the area was very fragile and he went on to say that there were long time positive business owners in the area south of MacArthur Highway. He commented that he did not have anything against Ms. Collins, but he said he had seen the negative impact of this particular site. He said all of those things impact their neighborhood. He said they could not afford the negative things that keep happening and he further stated that he cared and also had a responsibility to his employees.

First District Council Member Denise Moore said she agreed with all of Mr. Serafin's comments about the positive needs of this area. She went on to say that she felt that was exactly what Ms. Collin's was trying to do. She said she had attended several of her events and she said there had not been one problem at any of those events. She said a Plan of Operation would give Ms. Collins an opportunity to prove herself. She mentioned the minutes of a Site Application that was submitted in the last couple years for a different bar in this area and she said there weren't any concerns expressed. She said the same problems mentioned in relation to this site, could have also been stated for that establishment, but they weren't. She said they needed businesses that would provide another outlet for members of the community and she said they needed businesses that would do that. During more comments, Council Member Moore said UFS was a pillar of the community and she said they had made a huge commitment to the south side of Peoria. She went on to say that she did not want to do anything to harm them.

Commissioner Cassidy added that he also agreed with Attorney Zabek's comments about the Commission's role and he said he wanted to be clear that although there was personal information included in the packet of information that was provided during the previous request for this location, he did not consider it when he made his decision. He said he did not see anything that had changed and would justify him changing his decision.

In response, Attorney Zabek pointed out that his client had taken the initiative to add parking because of a concern mentioned at the previous hearing. He said that was a significant change. He also submitted that since the denial, there had actually been events from caterers at this location without any incidents or complaints.

Council Member Eric Turner said one good thing was that a Plan of Operation would allow those businesses and the community around that business to provide input on things that would be necessary going forward as far as the operation of this establishment. He said if at any time the licensee did not follow the guidelines of the Plan of Operation, a hearing would be held to determine if the applicant would continue to be allowed to hold a liquor license.

Hearing no more comments or questions, Chairman Miller called for the motion.

A lengthy discussion was held in regards to Plans of Operations and the impact on establishments.

After brief comments, Commissioner Cassidy moved to recommend approval of the request for a Class A (tavern) Liquor License, with a Subclass 2 (live entertainment) at 1801-03 SW Adams, contingent upon the approval of an acceptable Plan of Operation; seconded by Commissioner O'Brien.

Approved by roll call vote.

Chairman Miller stated this recommendation would be heard at the City Council Meeting to be held on Tuesday, December 11, 2018, at 6:00 p.m. and a representative of this establishment should be present at that meeting.



#### Dear Commissioners,

A site application has been received from Secrets VIP Lounge, Inc., d/b/a Secrets VIP Lounge, 1801-1803 SW Adams St., Peoria, Illinois for a Class A, Subclass 1A and Subclass 2 liquor license. Approval of this license would allow the applicant to operate a tavern with full bar service, with a closing time of 2:00 a.m. on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays and host live entertainment. This site most recently operated as Kareena's with the same liquor licenses before closing in December 2016.

Officer Kevin Slavens inspected the site which is at the corner of Adams Street and Edmund Street in an established commercial area of town. This location has historically held a liquor license dating back to April 1961. Surrounding businesses include: UFS Downtown Outlet Center, UFS Furniture Outlet, Donelson Corporation, Rocket Tire, Getz Fire Equipment and Dan's Tow Bar. The nearest residential neighborhood is approximately 400 feet to the west of this location in the 1000 block of W. George Street.

On July 19, 2018 Officer Kevin Slavens met with Ms. Alecia Collins and inspected the proposed site. The previous owner had remodeled the bar and made a number of improvements to the interior of the tavern. Ms. Collins told Officer Slavens that she is an event planning coordinator and has promoted several different types of events locally at the Travel Lodge, Scottish Rite Cathedral, and the Greenhut Memorial GAR Hall. Ms. Collins further stated that she plans to promote a wide variety of events and host different types of entertainment during all hours of the day at this proposed tavern.

Officer Slavens also spoke with Mr. Pierre Serafin, owner of UFS regarding this site application. Mr. Serafin has apprehensions that re-opening this site as another tavern would not be beneficial to his business nor the neighborhood. Mr. Serafin expressed frustrations with the last two previous tavern owners in regards to litter, police calls for service and patrons illegally parking in his UFS parking lots. Mr. Serafin and Officer Slavens walked around this proposed site and the adjacent property. The southwest side of the building's exterior is visually unappealing and in need of remodeling. The property adjacent to this site at 1807 SW Adams Street is a grassy vacant lot. Mr. Serafin further voiced his strong concerns regarding the shooting that occurred in front of Kareena's on September 28, 2016 (16-21460) and the negative publicity that incident possibly had with the public's perception of the viability and overall welfare of this commercial area of town.

This location operated as the La Copa Cabana from December 2010 until October 2012. There were 66 police calls for service and 17 Peoria Police reports filed during those dates. La Copa Cabana did have an alcohol related ordinance violation in September 2011. This site most recently operated as Kareena's from August 2013 to December 2016. There were 48 police calls for service and 22 Peoria Police reports filed during those dates. There were no alcohol related ordinance violations under Kareena's ownership. Calls for service for these two previous taverns would not be considered excessive and there were no known loud music or noise complaints at this location under the previous tavern owners.

The site application was previously heard on August 6, 2018 by the *City of Peoria Liquor Commission* and was denied. Mr. Serafin was present at that this meeting and voiced strong opposition against this site application. On November 26, 2018 the Peoria Police Department revisited the documentation that was provided by Mr. Serafin at this meeting. Officer Slavens went back to the immediate area of this proposed site and spoke to several business owners and residents. Mr. Craig Martin, owner of Donelson Corporation at 1723 SW Adams St., advised Officer Slavens that he had previously spoken with Mr. Serafin regarding this site application. Mr. Martin stated that he had numerous and constant litter issues on his property and that his building had been vandalized during the times when this site had previously operated as a tavern. Mr. Martin voiced his opposition to Officer Slavens against this site opening back up as a bar.

Officer Slavens also spoke with Mr. Andrew Schooley, owner of Rocket Tire, 312 Edmund St., who said they had previously spoken with Mr. Serafin regarding this site application. Mr. Schooley isn't opposed to a bar at this location, but didn't really have much to say for or against this site application. Officer Slavens also spoke with Mr. Jason Getz of Getz Fire, 1615 SW Adams St., and Mr. Kevin O'Brien of O'Brien Bros, 1604 SW Adams St. Both of them were very familiar with the previous bars that had operated at this site and had also previously spoken with Mr. Serafin. Both of them seemed to support opposition for this application. Mr. O'Brien also made mention to Officer Slavens that there had been a shooting at this site a few years ago. All four of these long standing businesses are listed on the petition summary that had been provided by Mr. Serafin, which includes signatures supporting denial of this site approval application from Mr. Martin, Mr. Getz and Mr. O'Brien.

Officer Slavens also attempted to make contact with every resident in the 1000-1100 block of W. George Street. Officer Slavens was able to speak with Mr. Thomas Wisdom at 1017 W. George Street. Mr. Wisdom was not aware of the site application at this location and didn't have anything to say against this application. Officer Slavens then spoke with Ms. Queen Parks at 1024 W. George Street. Ms. Parks told Officer Slavens that she was aware of the previous shooting at this site, but was somewhat non-comitial with an opinion on this application. Ms. Parks also signed the petition as a concerned neighbor. Ms. Marquita Britton at 1020 W. George called Officer Slavens on November 27, 2018 and informed him that she was familiar with the previous bar at this site, but really didn't have an opinion one way or another with this application as well.

The Peoria Police Department believes based on the recent objections with this site application that the proposed tavern at this location could be detrimental to nearby businesses and the surrounding neighborhood. The City of Peoria Liquor Code section 3-92, Suitability of Site, states in paragraph B the following:

- (1) That the establishment, maintenance, location or operation of the proposed site will not be detrimental to or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort or general welfare of the city.
- (3) That the proposed site and use, when considered separately or in conjunction with other licensed liquor establishments, will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the vicinity, including residences, schools, hospitals, places of worship and other businesses.
- (7) That the proposed site will not be injurious to the uses and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values with the neighborhood in which it is to be located.

Finally, site approvals are location specific and not owner specific, this area of town has six other taverns, all approximately one mile from this proposed site. After re-evaluating the provided documentation from Mr. Serafin and having Officer Slavens speak to those that live and work in the immediate area of this location, the Peoria Police Department does not believe there is an economic need, nor a desire from some of the nearby business owners and residents for another tavern in this area of town.

The Peoria Police Department recommends **denial** of this site application.
