That all reports, plans, plats and special provisions to be furnished by the ENGINEER pursuant to the AGREEMENT, will be in accordance with current standard specifications and policies of the DEPARTMENT. It is being understood that all such reports, plats, plans and drafts shall, before being finally accepted, be subject to approval by the LA and the DEPARTMENT.
3.	To attend conferences at any reasonable time when requested to do so by representatives of the LA or the Department.
4.	In the event plans or surveys are found to be in error during construction of the SECTION and revisions of the plans or survey corrections are necessary, the ENGINEER agrees that he will perform such work without expense to the LA, even though final payment has been received by him. He shall give immediate attention to these changes so there will be a minimum delay to the Contractor.
5.	That basic survey notes and sketches, charts, computations and other data prepared or obtained by the Engineer pursuant to this AGREEMENT will be made available, upon request, to the LA or the DEPARTMENT without cost and without restriction or limitations as to their use.
6.	That all plans and other documents furnished by the ENGINEER pursuant to this AGREEMENT will be endorsed by him and will show his professional seal where such is required by law.

The upper limit of impensation for these services shall not exceed \$125,000 for this supplement, \$500,000 for the project, without thorization from the LA. The attached Cost Estimate of Consultant Services (Exhibit B) provides an estimate of work tasks and the fee calculation based on the attached Scope of Services (Exhibit A). This estimate of work defort is the basis of the upper limit of compensation. as stipulated in paragraphs 1a, 1g, 1i, 2, 3, 5 and 6 in cordance with one of the following methods indicated by a check mark:

Payments shall be made as soon as practicable after receipt of each invoice. the services have been performed in accordance with the following schedule:
	a. Upon completion of detailed plans, special provisions, proposals and estimate of cost - being the work-required by paragraphs 1a through 1g under THE ENGINEER AGREES—to the satisfaction of the LA and their approval by the DEPARTMENT, 90-percent of the total fee due under this AGREEMENT based on the approved estimate of cost.
	b. Upon award of the contract for the improvement by the LA and its approval by the DEPARTMENT, 100 percent of ——the total fee due under the AGREEMENT based on the awarded contract cost, less any amounts paid under "a"——above.
	By Mutual agreement, partial payments, not to exceed-90-percent of the amount earned, may be made from-time to-time as the work-progresses.
3.	That, should the improvement be abandoned at any time after the ENGINEER has performed any part of the services provided for in paragraphs 1a, through 1h and prior to the completion of such services, the LA shall reimburse the ENGINEER for his actual costs pluspercent the time and expense incurred up to the time the ENGINEER is notified in writing of such abandonment. —"actual cost" being defined as in paragraph 2 of THE-LA-AGREES.
4.	That, should the LA require changes in any of the detailed plans, specifications or estimates except for those required pursuant to paragraph 4 of THE ENGINEER AGREEs, after they have been approved by the DEPARTMENT, the LA will pay the ENGINEER for such changes on a time and expense basis as calculated in Exhibit B. the basis-of-actual cost plus percent-to-cover-profit, overhead-and readiness to serve —"actual cost" being defined as in paragraph 2 of THE LA AGREES. It is understood that "changes" as used in this paragraph shall in no way relieve the ENGINEER of his

responsibility to prepare a complete and adequate set of plans and specifications.

It is Mutually Agreed,

- 1. That any difference between the ENGINEER and the LA concerning their interpretation of the provisions of this

 Agreement shall be referred to a committee of disinterested parties consisting of one-member appointed by the

 ENGINEER, one member appointed by the LA and a third member appointed by the two other members for disposition

 and that the committee's decision shall be final.
- 1. This AGREEMENT may be terminated by the LA upon giving notice in writing to the ENGINEER at his last known post office address. Upon such termination, the ENGINEER shall cause to be delivered to the LA all surveys, permits, agreements, preliminary bridge design & hydraulic report, drawings, specifications, partial and completed estimates and data, if any from traffic studies and soil survey and subsurface investigations with the understanding that all such material becomes the property of the LA. The ENGINEER shall be paid for any services completed and any services partially completed in accordance with Section 4-of THE LA AGREES.
- 3. That if the contract for construction has not been awarded one-year after the acceptance of the plans by the LA and their approval by the DEPARTMENT; the LA will pay the ENGINEER the balance of the engineering fee due to make 100 percent of the total fees due under this AGREEMENT, based on the estimate of cost as prepared by the ENGINEER and approved by the LA and the DEPARTMENT.
- 2. That the ENGINEER warrants that he/she has not employed or retained any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for the ENGINEER, to solicit or secure this contract, and that he/she has not paid or agreed to pay any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for the ENGINEER, any fee, commission, percentage, brokerage fee, gifts or any other consideration, contingent upon or resulting from the award or making of this contract. For Breach or violation of this warranty the LA shall have the right to annul this contract without liability.
- 3. That this Work Order (WO 16-11) is subject to all terms and conditions of the Standard Agreement for Professional Services between the CITY and ENGINEER dated April 12, 2016.

WORK ORDER NO.: 16-11 Hanson EXHIBIT A: SCOPE OF SERVICES SHERIDAN ROAD: RICHMOND AVE. TO ELEANOR PLACE SECTION NO. 16-00372-00-EG Supplement No. 1

Hanson Professional Services Inc. shall prepare project development studies and design plans, specifications and estimates for an improvement of Sheridan Road from Eleanor Pl. to Richmond Ave., in the City of Peoria for the City of Peoria (CITY). The proposed improvements include sidewalks, curbs, gutters, roadway profile and alignment adjustment, on-street bike lanes, on-street parking areas, and storm sewers.

The Project shall be designed in accordance with Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) standards and Specifications of the Illinois Department of Transportation, except as may be modified or approved by the City of Peoria Public Works Department.

Plans will be prepared in English units (feet) using Microstation software in accordance with CAD conventions of the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) in IL State Plane Coordinates (East Zone).

SERVICES: The Additional Scope of Services will be limited to the following:

A. ROW documents

- 1. Coordination with Quigg
- 2. Legal description preparation for forty-six (46) parcels. (Quigg Engineering)
- 3. Obtain updated title commitments/last deed of record for all Temporary easement and ROW parcels. (Quigg Engineering)
- 4. Prepare documents and coordinate with the City to vacate part of the Gale Avenue ROW to the adjacent property owner.

B. Land Acquisition Services for forty-six (46) parcels

- 1. Prepare Market Study and review waiver valuations signed by the City.
- Waiver Valuations: Prepare waiver valuation forms to be signed by the City for proposed temporary easements.
- 3. Negotiation Services:
 - i. Services will include the preparation of offer documents and conveyance documents appropriate for the nature of property ownership. This effort will include an attempt to present the offer package in person to the property owner, if the property owner or their representatives is located near the project site, and a minimum of three personal contacts per parcel, if required, to reach a negotiated settlement.
 - ii. In the event that settlement is reached, Hanson's negotiation efforts will be considered complete when the conveyance documents are delivered to the Client for approval and recording. In the event that settlement is not reached, Consultant's negotiation effort will be considered complete when each parcel is referred to the Client for condemnation after attempts to negotiate the acquisition have failed and 120 days for the offer date have expired.

- iii. Hanson will initiate negotiations upon the Client's certification of the parcels' waiver valuations.
- C. Roadway Geometric Design / Plan Preparation
 - 1. Revise driveways and sidewalk ramps per direction of the City and North Section construction.
 - 2. Revisions to sidewalk and driveways adjacent to development at the corner of Sheridan and Nebraska (Plasma Center).
 - 3. Revisions to plans to match adjacent construction north and south of the project limits.
 - 4. Revise retaining walls on west side of Sheridan south of Nebraska to reduce impact to adjacent properties. Revise construction/easement limits.
 - 5. Update plan sheets for revisions.

 - ii. Removals/Relocation Plan
 - iii. Pian/Profile Sheets

Charges for additional professional services performed by our firm for additional services, excluding land acquisition services, listed in the Scope of Services will be made on a time and materials basis according to the hourly rate schedules in the master agreement. Land acquisition services shall be paid on a lump sum per parcel basis. The additional compensation for these services shall not exceed \$125,000 without authorization from the LA. Total compensation for the project shall not exceed \$500,000 without authorization from the LA. Billings will be issued at least monthly, and will be based upon total services completed and expenses incurred at the time of billing.
