ROAD NAME CHANGE REQUEST

W Pendleton Place and W Gladstone Place

Purpose

The City of Peoria - Public Works, is looking to update W Pendleton Place and W Gladstone Place due to the confusion these roads will cause when addressing newly developed lots. Currently, both east-west facing roads converge into one on the west end of the subdivision. See *Current W Pendleton Place* map included in this document.

With the way the City of Peoria addresses their lots, addresses will increase from east to west on both Gladstone and Pendleton roads. Addresses with even numbers remain on the south (left) sides of the roads whereas odd numbered addresses will remain on north (right) sides of the roads. When converging on the west side of the subdivision, numbers will be similar and have even and odd numbered houses on the same sides of the street. Using proper signage in this area may help to alleviate some of the confusion if the road names were left as currently platted.

Solution

This problem, if fixed now, will affect the least number of property owners, eliminate confusion in the future, and require the least amount of signage.

The proposed change is to bring W Pendleton Place all the way up to parcel number 13-14-406-007 which can be viewed by looking at the *Updated W Pendleton Place* map included in this document. In this map, you can see the parcels that would be affected by this road name change highlighted in a thick black outline. These are currently undeveloped lots meaning they have not been addressed yet, but may be developed in the near future. These parcels would be changed to W Pendleton Place and be addressed accordingly when new houses are developed. Since no address or street name changes are proposed for parcels previously developed, this option will be the least intrusive change.
