Anthony Harris, Owner, presented a Site Application for a Class G-A (beer & wine only tavern) Liquor License for 315 Main St.

In discussion with Chairman Pro Tem Miller, Mr. Harris said they would like to serve burgers, wings and other sandwiches, similar to Buffalo Wild Wings.

Senior Urban Planner Kim Smith reported that the applicant had recently applied for a Change of Use through the Community Development Department.

Chairman Pro Tem Miller mentioned the reputation of the subject property and he pointed out the Police Department's concerns in regards to that location.

Liquor Investigator Jordan said due to the history and past issues at this location, the Police Department is recommending a deferral of the site application until a Plan of Operation was agreed upon between the applicant and the City of Peoria regarding the operation of the business. He said he did not see any problems with the business as presented, he said they just wanted something in writing for the future of that location.

Deputy Corporation Counsel Williams advised that the application be deferred to allow the applicant and the Police Department time to come up with an agreement to be brought back before the Liquor Commission.

In discussion with Liquor Investigator Jordan, Mr. Harris said they wanted to open for business by the end November.

After more comments, Deputy Corporation Counsel Williams strongly suggested that the applicant consider the G-B (beer & wine only restaurant) Liquor License. She explained that there would not be a requirement of the amount of food sold, but they would be required to have a kitchen.

Mr. Harris said they planned to add a full kitchen and he said he did not want to operate as a bar or tavern. He said he chose the Class G-A (beer & wine only tavern) Liquor License because he was concerned about meeting food sale requirements. He then said he did not have a problem with changing his request from a Class G-A (beer & wine only tavern) to a Class G-B (beer & wine only restaurant) with the addition of a Plan of Operation.

Building Inspector Moran informed Mr. Harris that the Community Development Department would need to review drawings for the new kitchen.

Hearing no further questions, Chairman Pro Tem Miller called for the motion.

Commissioner White moved to recommend deferral of the Site Application for a Class G-A Liquor License for 315 Main St., with the stipulation that the application is changed to a Class G-B (beer & wine

only restaurant) and a Plan of Operation is agreed upon and brought back before the Commission on November 3, 2014; seconded by Commissioner Coates.

Anthony Harris, Owner, presented a Site Application for a Class G-B (beer & wine only restaurant) Liquor License for 315 Main St.

In discussion with Chairman Cassidy, Mr. Harris said he was in agreement with the Plan of Operation with the City of Peoria for his proposed establishment.

Liquor Investigator Jordan said if the applicant was in agreement and signed off on everything listed, the Plan of Operation would be sent to the Mayor for his signature.

Deputy Corporation Counsel Sonni Williams pointed out there may be Community Development Department concerns that needed to be addressed prior to sending the case on to the City Council. She said there was a request to defer the application until all Community Development issues had been corrected, instead of the Commission recommending approval contingent upon those issues being addressed.

Senior Urban Planner Kim Smith reported there were no Zoning issues and she stated a Zoning Certificate had been issued to the applicant. She said there may be Building Code violations at this location.

In response to a question from Commissioner O'Brien in regards to whether the applicant would be able to serve fried foods, Mr. Harris said they had decided to remove fried foods from their menu because of building requirements to have an exhaust hood installed.

In more discussion, Liquor Investigator said the Police Department's recommendation was based on approval of the type of restaurant that would serve burgers, wings, etc. Mr. Harris said they could definitely still serve those items, but they would not be able to deep fry them.

Building Inspector Stevens said depending on the type of liquor license, the Building Department would need to know which direction the applicant wanted to take as far as meeting food requirements. He then gave examples of different types of restaurants that were not required to install exhaust hoods. He said discussion was also held with the applicant with regards to the use of a vent-less self-contained appliance to cook different food items.

In discussion with Deputy Corporation Counsel Williams, Building Inspector Stevens said there weren't any outstanding Building Code violations. He said there may be issues with the Fire Department.

Fire Captain McGann reported that there was a residential dwelling above the subject property. He said he had been working with the landlord in regards to addressing that issue.

Chairman Cassidy expressed his concerns in regards to requiring the applicant to come back before the Commission for site approval after all Community Development concerns were met. He said the Commission had never faced this type of an issue before and he asked how the Commission would be able to do that without requiring the applicant to make all expenditures before even knowing if they

would obtain site approval. He said he felt they were going backwards and they were putting too much burden on the applicant. He went on to say that he understood that before the liquor license could be issued, everything that was not in compliance had to be addressed. He said he did not understand why they would be required to tie all of that into the site approval process.

Hearing no further questions, Chairman Cassidy called for the motion.

Commissioner Miller moved to recommend approval of the Site Application for a Class G-B (beer & wine only restaurant) Liquor License for 315 Main St., including the Plan of Operation and the issuance of a C of O from the Building Department; seconded by Commissioner Coates.

AGREED LIQUOR LICENSE PLAN OF OPERATION

Licensee: Sauced
Premises: 315 Main Street, Peoria, IL 61602
Application Type: Class G-B

The City of Peoria Liquor Commissioner and the above-named licensee have agreed to this Plan of Operation for a Class G-B liquor license with the listed subclasses under the following conditions:

1. The Licensee shall maintain in working condition, external video surveillance cameras (the "cameras") conforming to the following:
 - a. The cameras can view and record persons or activities on both entrances and the common areas of the licensed premises;
 - b. The cameras are sufficiently light sensitive and provide sufficient image resolution to produce easily discernible images;
 - c. The images recorded on the cameras are capable of being viewed through use of compact disc, electronic file transfer and other digital media that are capable of being transferred to a variety of portable form of media, including, but not limited to, compact disc and digital video disc; and
 - d. All camera recordings shall be preserved at least 30 days after recording and shall be available immediately to the police upon request.
2. The Licensee shall clear the sidewalk of debris, litter and rubbish in front of the establishment, Sauced, daily. The Licensee shall "powerwash" the sidewalk in front of the establishment, Sauced, weekly.
3. The Licensee establishment shall be closed from 12:01am to 6:00am on Saturday and Sunday mornings. On all other days, the Licensee establishment shall be closed from 11:00pm to 6:00am.
4. The Licensee shall not cover the front windows in any manner that prevents sight into the establishment.
5. The kitchen must be open and operational and food service shall be available during all business hours.
6. The Licensee and each of its owners shall not seek a gaming license for 1 year from the date this document is signed.

The agreed conditions of this liquor license are legally binding and may be enforced by the City of Peoria. Violations of the above-stated agreed conditions may result in the imposition of a fine and/or suspension or revocation of all licenses issued to the licensee. Violations of the above-stated agreed conditions may

also result in the issuance of cease and desist orders prohibiting the activity which violates the condition of the liquor license.

The agreed conditions of the liquor license shall apply to the business address and licensee and to all officers, managers, members, partners and direct or indirect owners of the entity of which is licensed. The sale of the business purchasing the stock of the licensed entity shall be subject to the same agreed conditions set for in this plan of operation.

From time to time when requested by the Mayor, the Licensee agrees to amend this Agreed Plan of Operation to add conditions to address issues and concerns stemming from the operation of the licensed premises.

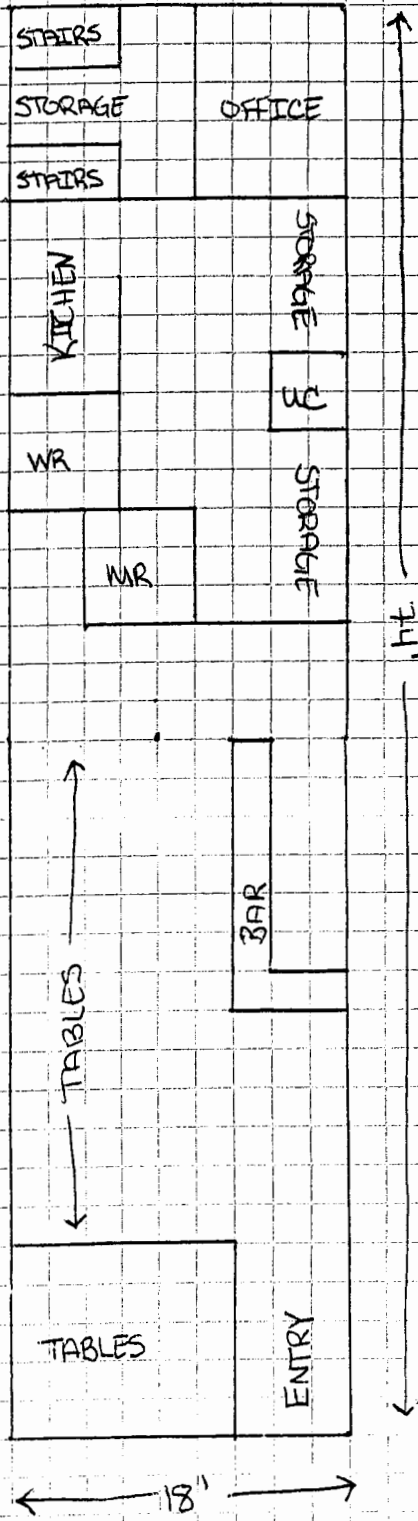

Dear Commissioners,

A site application has been received from Sauced of Illinois, LLC, d/b/a Sauced, 315 Main St., Peoria, Illinois, for a Class G-A liquor license. The application is to allow a new tavern, serving beer and wine only, and limited to patrons ages 21 and over, at this location.

Officer Jordan inspected this location which is part of downtown Peoria. This site is neighbored by other businesses including a restaurants, attorney's offices, and similar businesses. Two nearby restaurants hold liquor licenses. This location previously operated as the tavern Pounders. Pounders held a Class A liquor license with 4:00 a.m. closing hours and operated as a nightclub. Pounders was a source of repeated police calls, including a patron being shot in front of the tavern. Complaints of loud music, trash, and safety concerns were received by Officer Jordan from nearby businesses. In approximately 6 months of operation there were 3 major liquor violations committed by the operator of Pounders eventually leading to the revocation of their liquor license and revocation of site approval for this location. There were 9 police reports filed regarding incidents at Pounders including 3 battery/aggravated battery reports.

Officer Jordan spoke to the applicant regarding this site and informed the applicant of previous issues with a tavern at this location. The applicant stated the business would be a tavern selling wings and hamburgers and that he was currently installing a kitchen to meet those needs. He stated he intended on being open from 10:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. or possibly later depending on downtown events and business. Officer Jordan inquired as to why the applicant wasn't applying for a restaurant license and the applicant indicated he was not sure the business would meet the 50% food requirement. Officer Jordan also inquired about opening without alcohol and the applicant stated he felt the beer sales would be a large part of his business. The applicant stated he envisioned the business being similar to Buffalo Wild Wings.

The police department has concerns regarding site approval allowing a tavern to return to this location. The police department realizes that this business model is different than the previous tenant and appreciates that food is being offered and that liquor sales are limited to beer and wine. However, based on the past issues and concerns of the neighboring businesses the police department has serious misgivings about the approval of this site. The police department believes assurances need to be in place to protect the neighboring businesses and prevent past issues from returning.


