AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PEORIA ADDING SUBCLASS 12 SUPPLEMENTAL LIQUOR LICENSE

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria is a home rule unit of government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois 1970, and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs including regulating and licensing the retail sale and service of alcoholic;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: Chapter 3 of the Code of the City of Peoria is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken words and by adding the following underlined words.

Section 3-1. Definitions.

Supermarket grocery store means a large form of the traditional grocery store, offering a wide variety of food and household products, but is smaller and more limited in the range of merchandise than a hypermarket or big-box market which sells grocery, but carries a wider range of items such as clothing, equipment, electronics, furniture, household cleaning appliances or machines such as vacuums, and other items traditionally sold in a department store.

Sec. 3-53. - Supplemental licenses and fees.

(a) Upon application to the local liquor commissioner by a license holder, the following supplemental licenses may be issued after approval by the local liquor commissioner and the payment of the fees set forth herein:

(13) Subclass (12). A supplemental license may be obtained by a licensee currently holding a valid Class "C" (grocery) license issued under this chapter in which the square footage of the building of the established establishment is at least 50,000 square feet and meets the definition of a supermarket grocery store as defined in section 3-1 of this chapter, authorizing the retail sale of alcoholic beverages for on-site consumption as part of a full service restaurant ,with wait staff, that serves prepared meals which excludes the serving of snacks as the primary meal only in an area designated and operated as a restaurant as defined in section 3-1 of this chapter. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to authorize a Class C licensee with a subclass 12 supplemental license to qualify for subclasses that are available only to Class "B" (restaurant) license holders. The annual fee for this supplemental license shall be \$1,000.00.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its

passage and publication.
