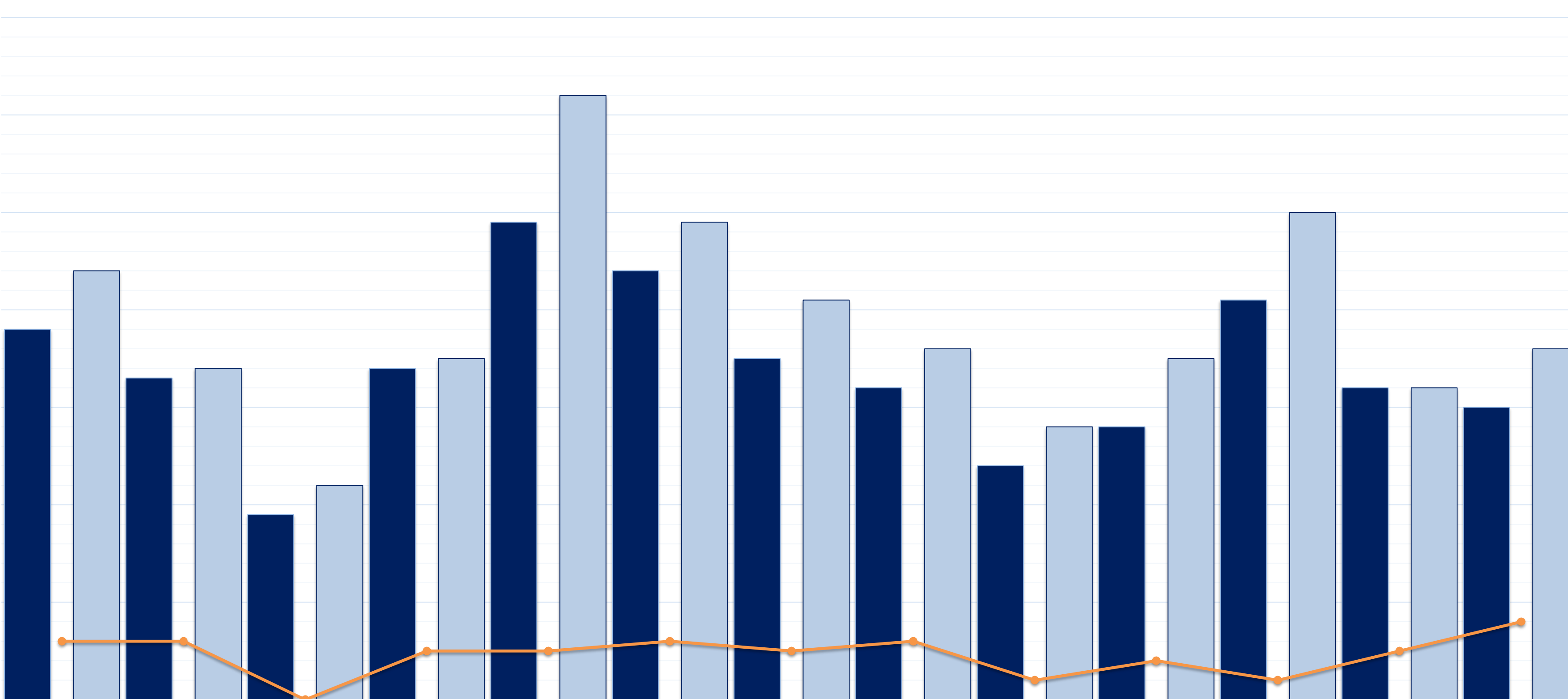

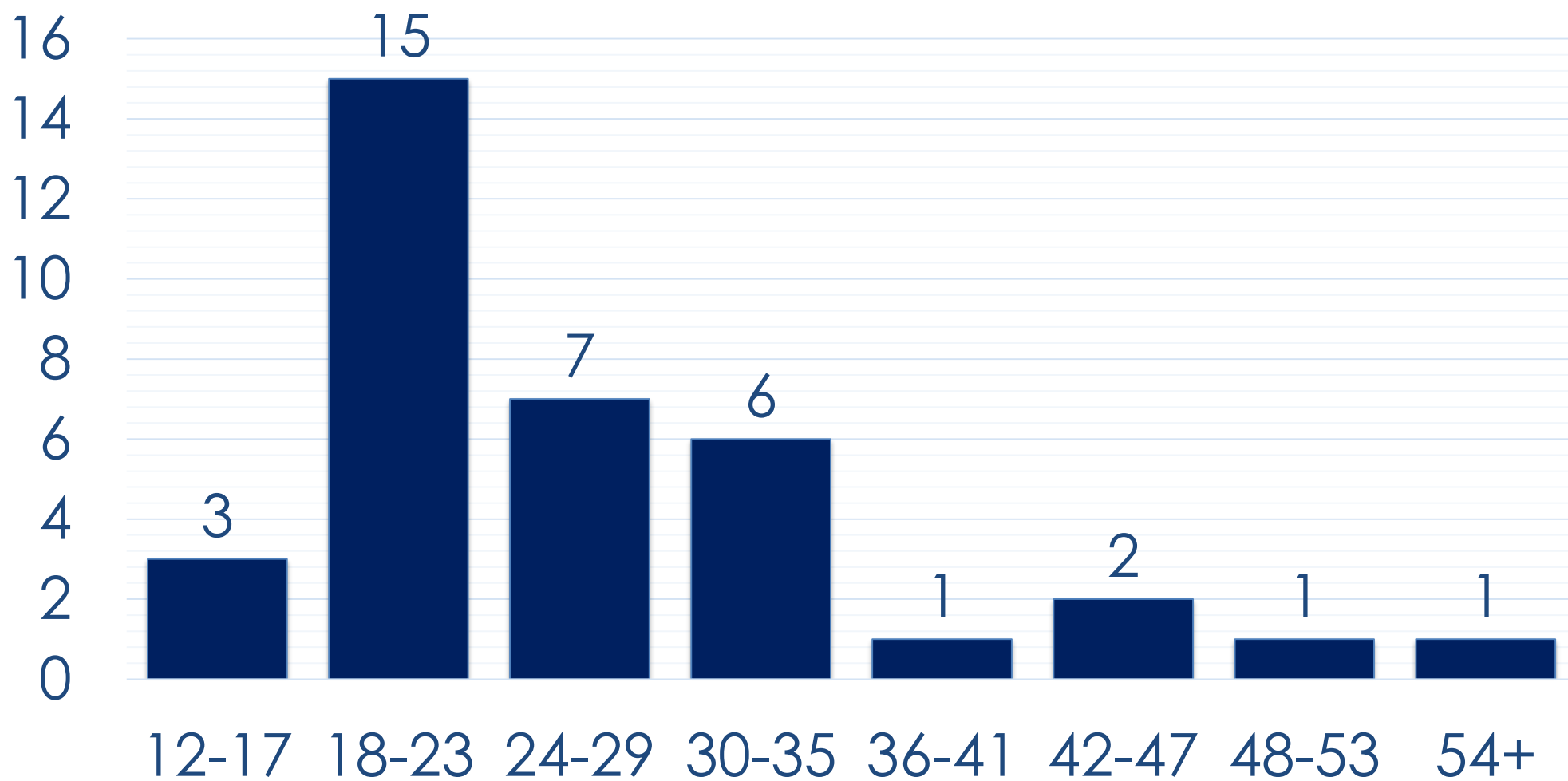

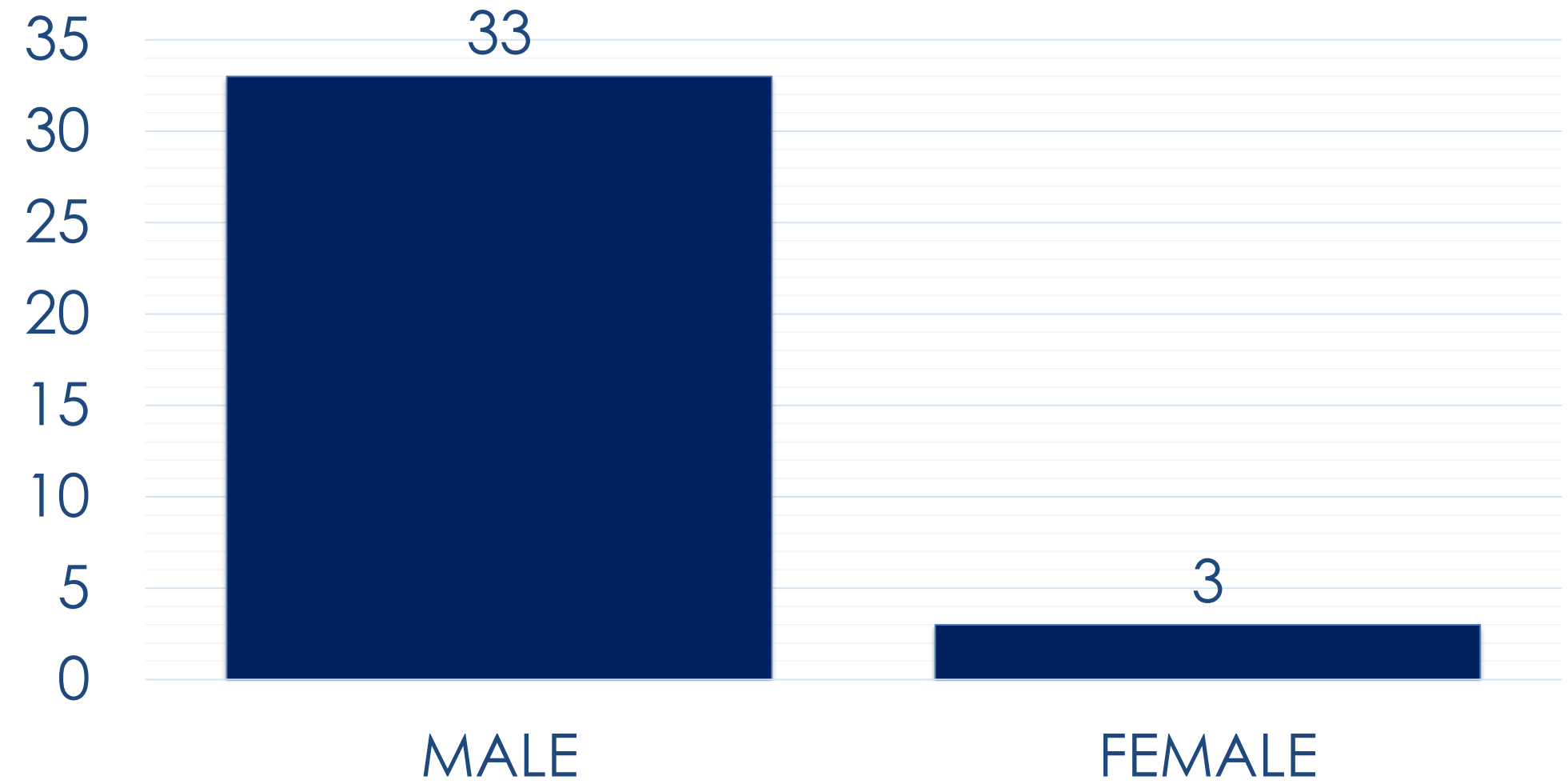

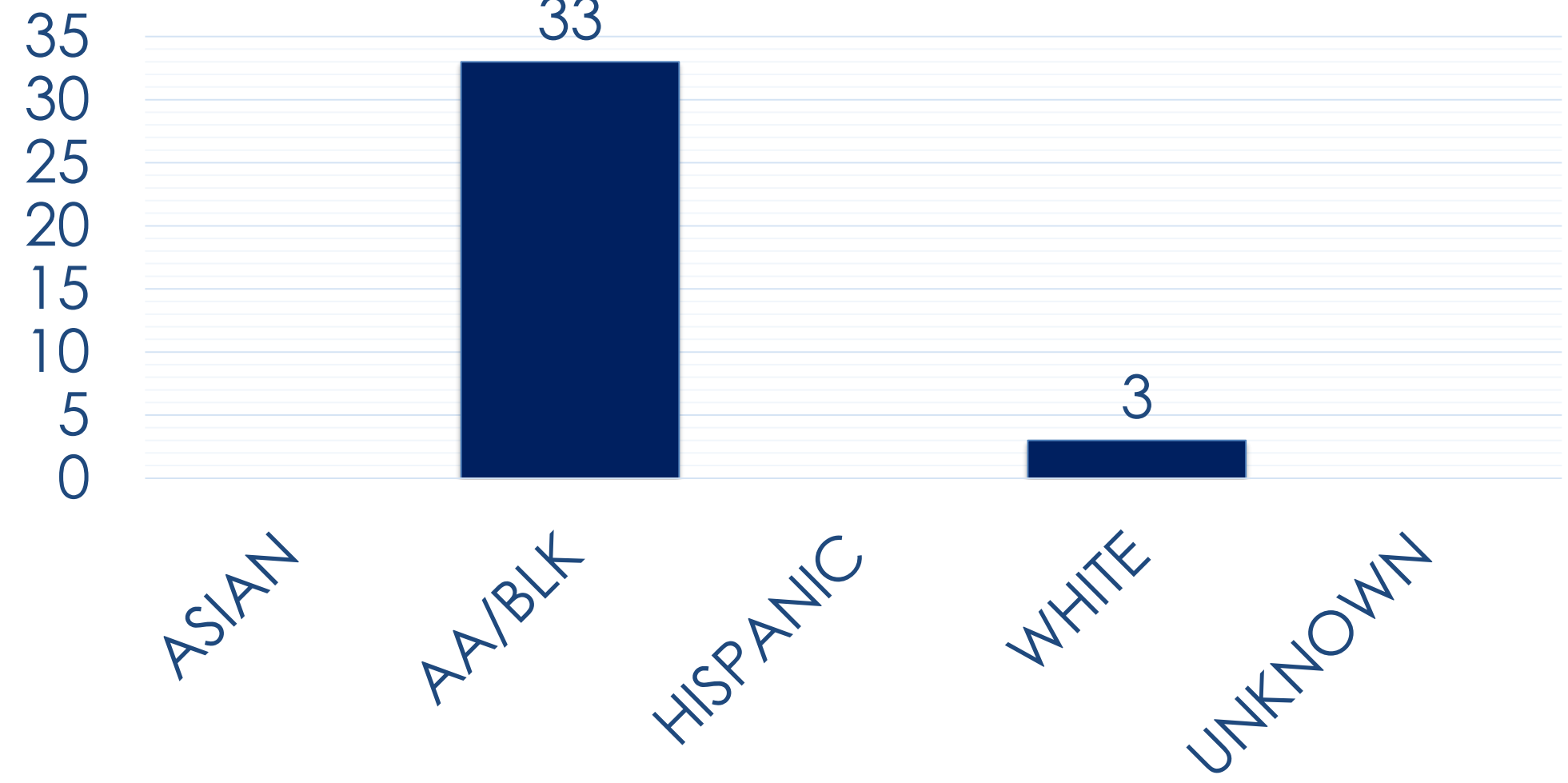
SHOOTING VICTIMS - AGE

SHOOTING VICTIMS - RACE



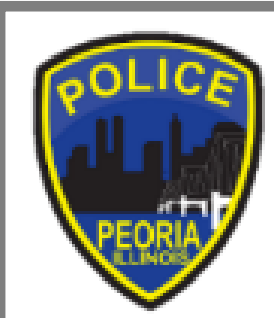
SHOTSPOTTER STATISTICS

- # Shooting Incidents 30 (60.0% or 18 incidents w/a ShotSpotter alert)
- # Shooting Victims 36 (55.6% or 20 victims w/a ShotSpotter alert)
- # Shooting Murders 8 (50.0% or 4 victims w/a ShotSpotter alert)

- # ShotSpotter alerts = 372

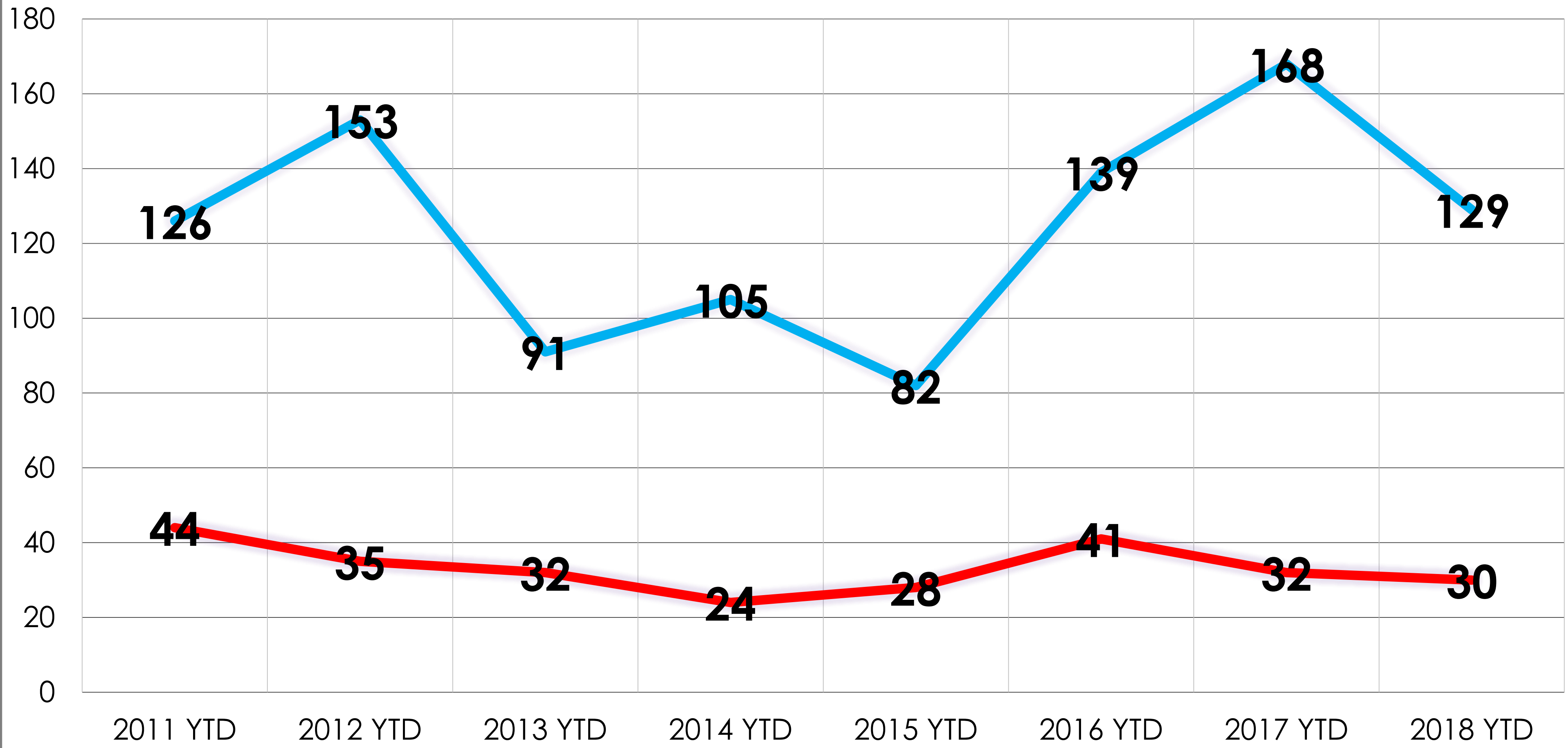
Below statistics occurred on the scene of the actual ShotSpotter alert:

- # ShotSpotter alerts where a gun was recovered = 26
- # ShotSpotter alerts where a gun was seized from an arrestee = 10
- # ShotSpotter alerts where a suspect was interviewed = 21
- # ShotSpotter alerts where property damaged occurred = 42

- **23 TOTAL SERVICES RECEIVED**

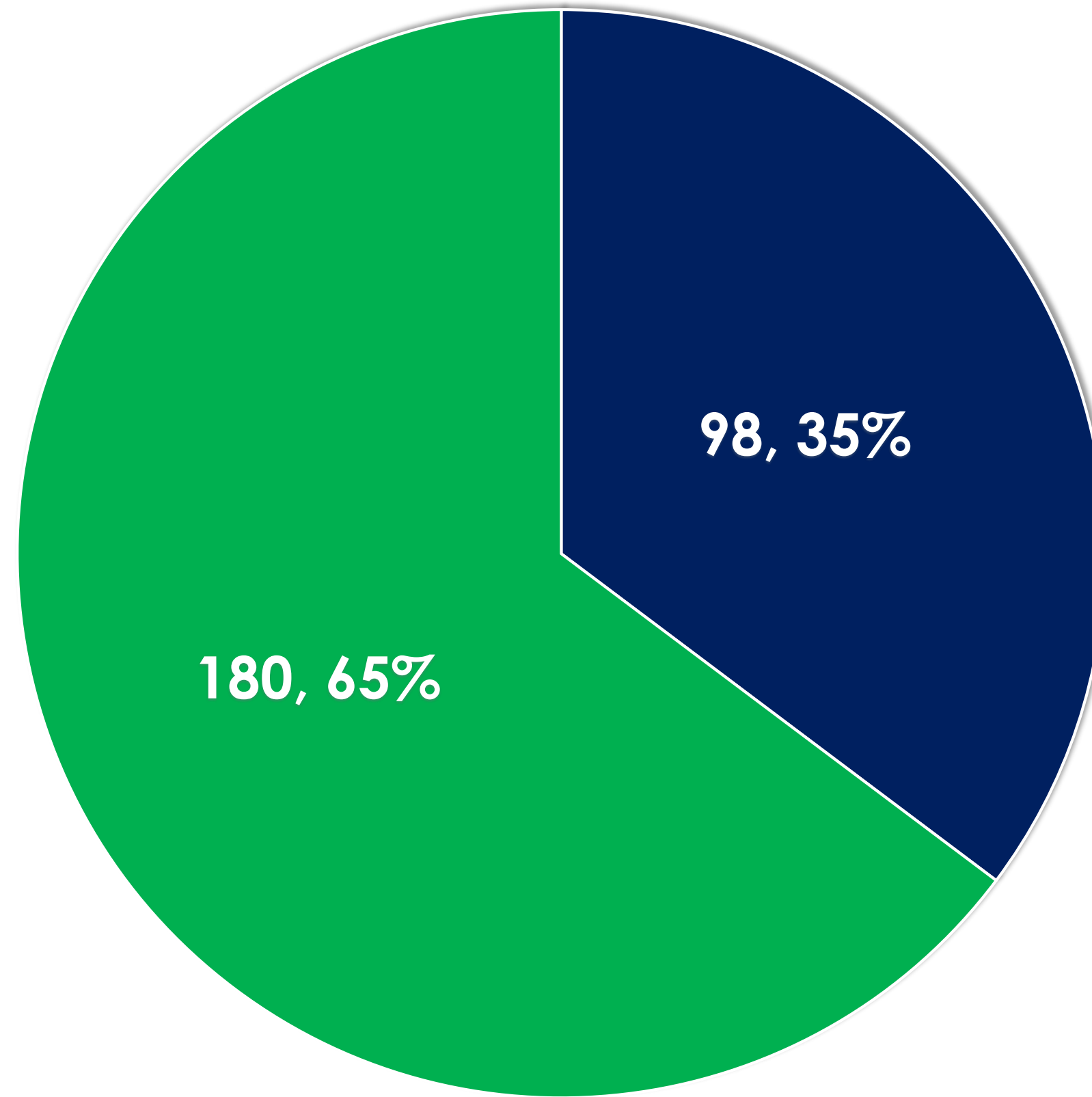

■ NOT REARRESTED AFTER CALL-IN ■ REARRESTED AFTER CALL-IN

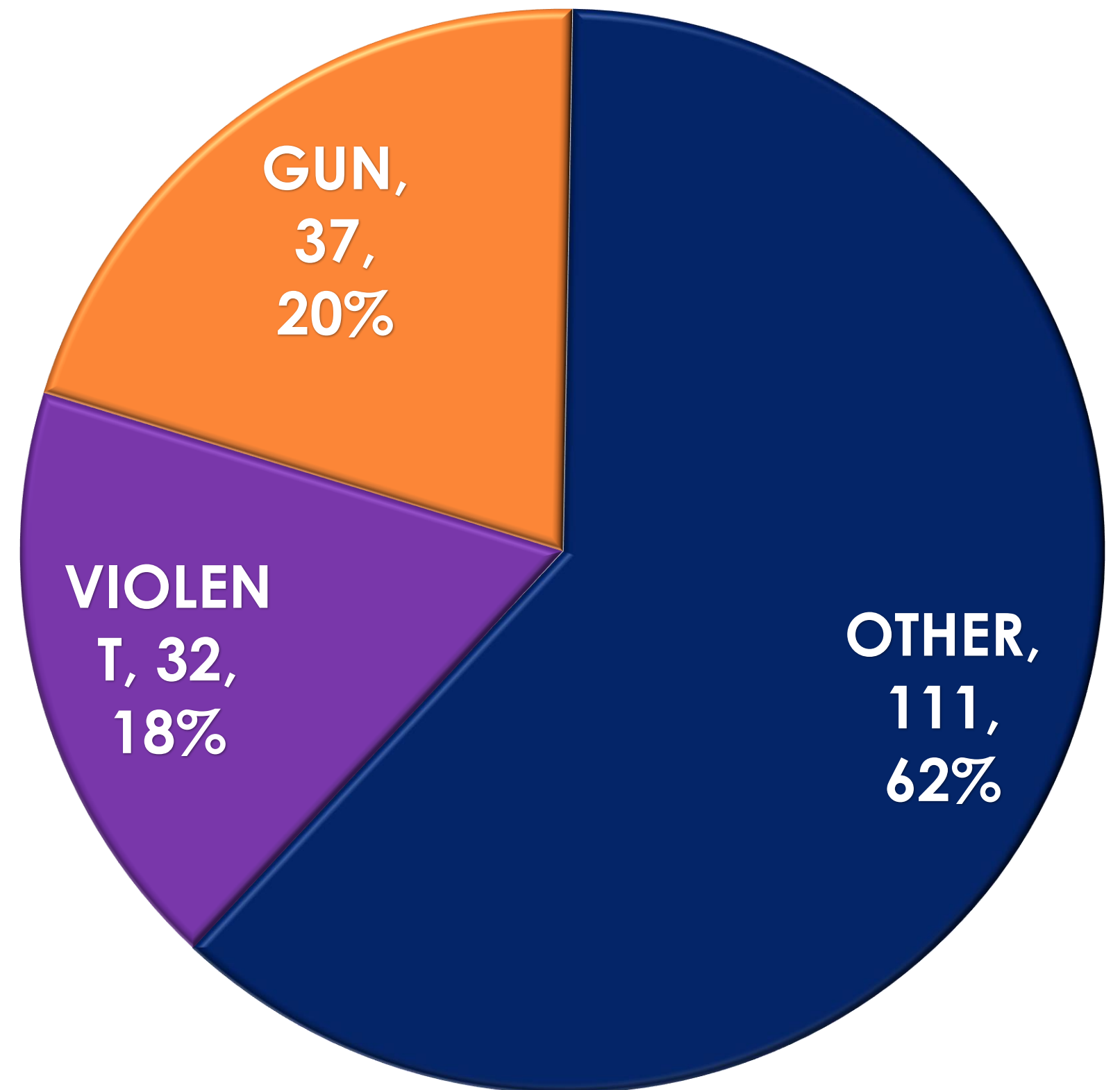
