RESOLUTION COMMITTING LOCAL FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Peoria, Illinois has taken action to submit a Rebuild Illinois competitive public infrastructure application; and

WHEREAS, receipt of Rebuild Illinois grant assistance is essential to allow the City of Peoria to convert Fulton Plaza to a two-way street, incorporating green infrastructure elements that will improve sustainability and livability or downtown residents, workers and visitors while also creating a safer downtown for the cyclist, pedestrians and drivers; and

WHEREAS, criteria are such that financial participation by the grantee is required in conjunction with Rebuild Illinois funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria has certain monies allocated for the above-referenced project with cash on hand, as needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Peoria does hereby commit \$150,000.00 from the Downtown Conservation TIF for the Fulton Plaza project for use in conjunction with a Rebuild Illinois Public Infrastructure Grant, such funds to equal 8.10% of the estimated total project cost of \$1,850,000.00
