AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE BROMPTON COURT RIGHT OF WAY FROM ALLEN ROAD TO BROMPTON COURT

WHEREAS, the right-of-way more particularly hereinafter described is no longer of value to the public; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Peoria, the public interest will be served by vacating said right-of-way as hereinafter described on Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA:

<u>Section 1.</u> All of the right-of-way as described and shown on the vacation plat hereinafter attached as Exhibit A, which plat for greater certainty is made a part of this ordinance, is hereby vacated and closed, with the exception of reservations contained in Section 2 hereof. Said right-of-way is no longer required for public use, and the public interest will be served by such vacation as is hereinafter provided for.

Section 2. The City of Peoria hereby reserves unto all public utility companies presently operating in, upon, over and under said right-of-way, all rights and privileges heretofore granted by City ordinances, including but not limited to, rights under franchises and agreements, which said rights and privileges shall continue in full force and effect the same as if this Ordinance otherwise vacating said right-of-way had not been adopted and passed; such rights and privileges with respect to said public utility companies are to remain in effect until, and to terminate upon, the abandonment or release of such use or the relocation of such use outside the public right-of-way herein vacated.

It is further provided that no building or other structures shall be erected on the said right-of-way herein set forth, or other said reservations be made of such area which would interfere with use, maintenance, renewal or reconstruction of the facilities of said public utilities.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage and approval, subject, however, to the conditions of Section 2 hereof.
