Enclosed is an application from *The Yellow Bear Foundation* for a Class H temporary liquor license. This license will be used on Saturday, March 14, 2020 from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. in the 600 block of SW Water St., Peoria Illinois. The Yellow Bear Foundation is hosting a pre/post-race fundraiser during the Blarney Blitz 5k. This license will allow for the sale and on-site consumption of alcoholic beverages during the event. Nothing was found that would prohibit these individuals or this organization from holding the requested liquor license.

The Peoria Police Department has no objections to this temporary liquor license request.

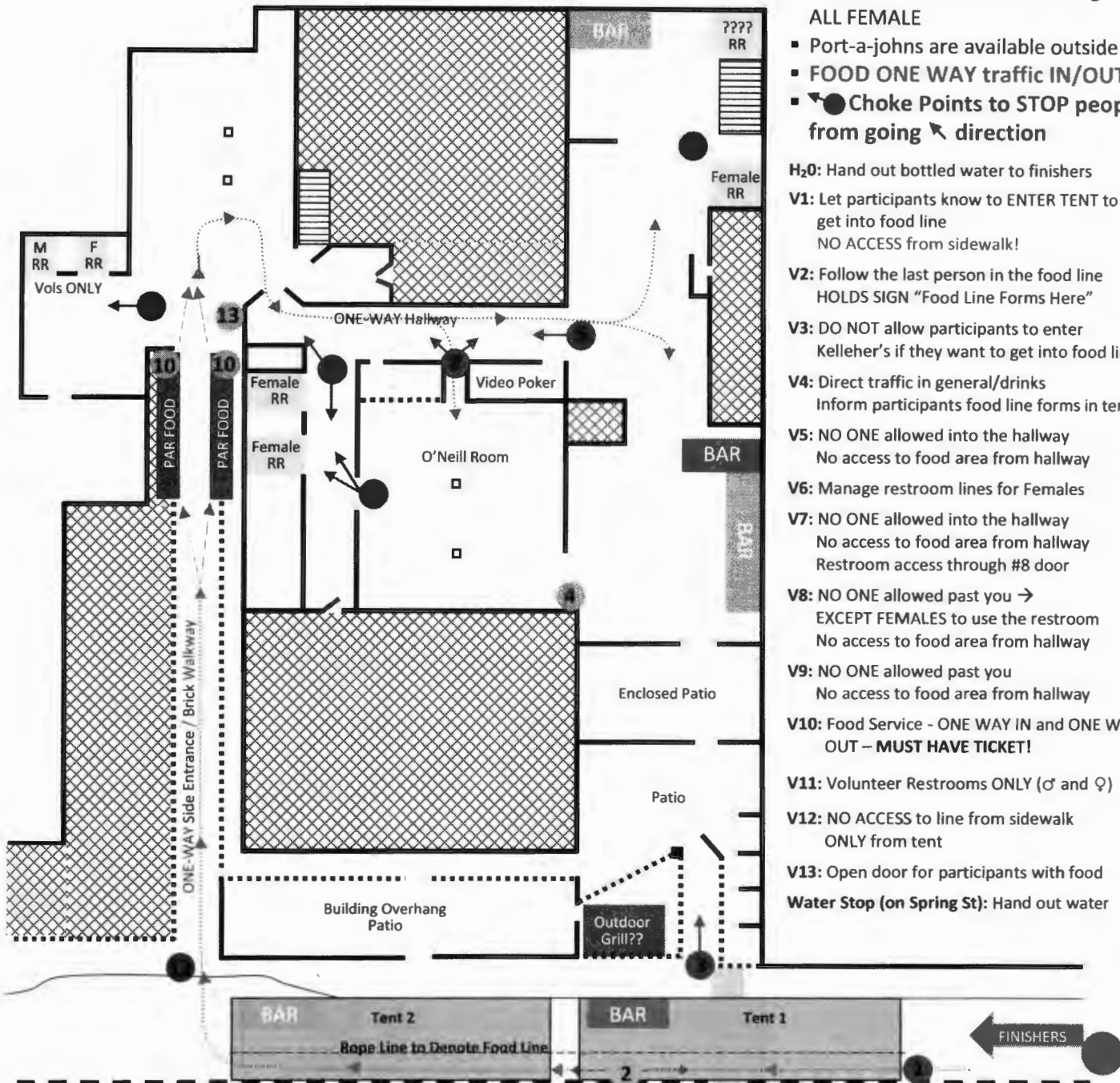

Blarney Blitz Event Layout



- ALL indoor restrooms are changed to ALL FEMALE
 - Port-a-johns are available outside
 - FOOD ONE WAY traffic IN/OUT
 - ● Choke Points to STOP people from going ↖ direction
- V2: Hand out bottled water to finishers
- V1: Let participants know to ENTER TENT to get into food line
NO ACCESS from sidewalk!
- V2: Follow the last person in the food line
HOLDS SIGN "Food Line Forms Here"
- V3: DO NOT allow participants to enter Kelleher's if they want to get into food line
- V4: Direct traffic in general/drinks
Inform participants food line forms in tent
- V5: NO ONE allowed into the hallway
No access to food area from hallway
- V6: Manage restroom lines for Females
- V7: NO ONE allowed into the hallway
No access to food area from hallway
Restroom access through #8 door
- V8: NO ONE allowed past you →
EXCEPT FEMALES to use the restroom
No access to food area from hallway
- V9: NO ONE allowed past you
No access to food area from hallway
- V10: Food Service - ONE WAY IN and ONE WAY OUT – MUST HAVE TICKET!
- V11: Volunteer Restrooms ONLY (♂ and ♀)
- V12: NO ACCESS to line from sidewalk
ONLY from tent
- V13: Open door for participants with food
- Water Stop (on Spring St):** Hand out water

Participant Food: Chicken Pot Pie, Shepard's Pie, Chicken Fingers, Spinach Dip, Assorted Veggies
Participant Shocktop Green Beer at "Green Bars" ONLY

Parking Lot – Volunteers can park anywhere

6:30am: PP, Water Stop, Course Volunteers Meet at RC Outfitters
7:00am Food Servers Meet at Kelleher's (*7:30am if do training on Monday)
8:00am: Race Starts/Kelleher's Opens to General Public
