Cierra Sargent, Owner, and Jeremy Sargent, Chef, presented a Site Application for a Class G-B (beer and wine only restaurant) Liquor License at 3127 N. Prospect.

In discussion with Chairman O'Brien, Ms. Sargent gave a brief overview of the proposed menu items for their new restaurant. She referred to their menu that was provided and she explained they would provide a variety of different loaded fry concepts such as lobster, shrimp & chicken alfredo, chili & cheese, etc.

Mr. Sargent reported he had been a chef for the past 17 years and he noted several different local chefs with whom he had worked. With respect to liquor, he explained wine always paired well with pasta and seafood, so they felt it would compliment their menu.

During more discussion, Mr. Sargent clarified that due to COVID-19 pandemic, they had planned to use bottled beer and wine only. He said their hours of operation were from 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Tuesday thru Saturday.

In response to a question from Commissioner Coates, Mr. Sargent reported they had planned to be open for business on May 25<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Matt Hume, Property Manager, spoke in favor of the request for site approval. He said he felt the new restaurant would be good fit for this location.

Hearing no more comments or questions, Chairman O'Brien called for the motion.
