AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PEORIA PERTAINING TO LICENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria, Illinois is a home rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Peoria, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. There shall be added to the Code of the City of Peoria the following underlined words and deleting the following stricken words in Chapter 18 of the Code of the City of Peoria pertaining to adult businesses:

Article II. Amusements Generally

Sec. 18-28. - License fees.

- (a) The applicant for a license under this article shall pay the city treasurer, prior to filing an application, the respective annual fee:
 - (1) Amusement arcade\$200.00 \$220.00
 - (2) Automatic amusement device, per machine25.00 \$30.00
 - (3) Bowling alley, per lane15.00 \$20.00 or150.00 \$200.00 whichever is less.
 - (4) *Carnival*, per week50.00 \$60.00
 - (5) *Mechanical music device*, per machine25.00 \$30.00
 - (6) Motion picture theatre:
 - a. Less than 400 seats 100.00 \$110.00
 - b. 400—799 seats150.00 \$165.00
 - c. 800 or more seats200.00 \$220.00
 - (7) Pool halls, per table15.00 \$20.00 or150.00

whichever is less.

(b) Should the application be denied, the license fee shall be refunded to the applicant.

Article III. Adult Businesses Generally

Sec. 18-82. - License fees.

The city council hereby establishes the following fees for sexually oriented adult business licenses:

Initial sexually oriented adult business license and subsequent renewals\$200.00 \$220.00

Adult business employee license and annual renewal license 100.00 \$110.00

Kitchen staff, including dishwashers and cooks but not including waitstaff - Initial and annual renewal50.00 \$60.00

Article IV. Adult Businesses Generally

Sec. 18-97. - License fees.

The applicant for a license under this article shall pay the city treasurer, prior to filing the application, a fee of \$250.00 for the first video gaming terminal and \$50.00 for each additional \$300 for each video gaming terminal per license year, beginning January 1, 2016. The applicant for a license under this article shall pay the city treasurer, prior to filing a fee of \$500 for each video gaming terminal per license year, beginning January 1, 2017. If the license is denied, the license fee shall be refunded to the applicant.

Article V. Auctions and Auctioneers

Sec. 18-162. - Fee.

Before any auctioneer's license shall be issued, the applicant therefor shall pay to the city treasurer a fee in the sum of \$100.00. \$110.00.

Article VI. Dance Halls

Sec. 18-209. - Fees.

- (a) The applicant shall pay the city treasurer prior to filing an application, a fee of \$50.00 \$60.00 per year or part thereof. Should the application be denied, the license fee shall be refunded to the applicant.
- (b) The fee for the supplemental youth dance license shall be \$30.00 \$40.00 per night or \$300.00 \$400.00 per year. Any licensee holding ten youth dances in any one calendar year shall be deemed to have paid for a yearly supplemental youth dance license which may be issued upon proper application approval.

Article VIII. Outdoor Advertisers

Sec. 18-338. - Fees.

The annual license fee for the license required by this division shall be \$25.00 \$30.00, where the licensee uses or maintains not more than 25 billboards or signboards; and if such licensee uses or maintains more than 25 billboards or signboards, such annual license fee shall be \$250.00 \$300.00. Each application for a license as an outdoor advertiser contemplated by this article shall be accompanied by a statement under oath of the number of billboards, signboards or display boards used by the applicant in the city for such outdoor advertising. Upon the acquisition or use by construction or otherwise of more than 25 billboards as provided by this article, such licensee shall give notice in writing of such additional number of billboards or signboards and shall be required to pay the annual license fee where the number of billboards shall exceed 25 in number. Such annual license fee shall be due and payable on January 1 of each year.

Article IX. Peddlers

Sec. 18-378. - Fees.

The applicant for a peddler's license under this division shall pay to the city treasurer prior to filing an application a fee of \$50.00 \$60.00 per calendar year or part thereof. Should the application be denied, the license fee shall be refunded to the applicant.

Article XI. Secondhand Dealers

Sec. 18-473. - Fees.

The applicant for a license required by this division shall pay the city treasurer prior to filing an application a nonrefundable licensee fee. The fee for dealers lawfully established and licensed to operate within the City of Peoria for a period of at least one full year prior to application, shall be \$150.00.\$165.00. The fee for all other dealers shall be \$500.00 \$550.00 All fees are per calendar year or part thereof and licensee fees shall not be prorated.

Article XIII. Transient Merchants

Sec. 18-569. - Fees; duration.

The fees for a transient merchant's or a sponsor's license under this division shall be \$50.00 \$60.00 for an initial license and \$25.00 \$30.00 for any subsequent license issued within 12 months. All such license fees must be paid in advance. If any such licensee desires to continue in business after the expiration of such license, a new license must be secured in the same manner and upon the same terms as the original license.

Article XIV. Cigarettes

Sec. 18-614. - Fees.

The applicant for a license under this division shall pay the city treasurer prior to filing an application a fee of \$50.00 \$60.00 per year or part thereof for each license.
