

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING DIVISION 2 OF ARTICLE VI OF CHAPTER 20 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PEORIA RELATING TO CONCEALABLE DEADLY WEAPONS

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria is a home rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, in response to U.S. 7th Circuit Court of Appeals' holding in *Moore v. Madigan*, 702 F.3d 933 (7th Cir. 2012), that the Illinois' ban on carrying concealed handguns was unconstitutional, the Illinois General Assembly enacted the Firearm Concealed Carry Act, 430 ILCS 66/1, *et seq.*, which established a system for the issuance of concealed carry permits that started in 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Peoria, Illinois, desires to update the Code of the City of Peoria to be fully compliant with the Illinois Firearm Concealed Act by repealing Division 2 of Article VI of Chapter 20 of the City Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: Division 2 of Article VI, Sections 20-181 through 20-190 of Chapter of the Code of the City of Peoria is repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and publication in pamphlet form.
