ORDINANCE NO. 17,176

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 28 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PEORIA PERTAINING TO PARKING BAN FINES FOR EMERGENCY SNOW ROUTES

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria is a home rule unit of government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois 1970, and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Chapter 28 of the Code of the City of Peoria is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken words and by adding the following underlined words:

Section 28-83. - Amounts of settlement.

- (a) Any person accused of violating those sections of this chapter set forth in this section may settle and compromise the claim against him for such violation by paying, in person or by mail, to the city treasurer, the following amounts:
 - (5) The sum of \$200.0050.00 within seven days, the sum of \$250.0075.00 after seven days and the sum of \$300.00100.00 after 30 days from the time such offense was committed, for violation of sections 28-386 through 28-391, inclusive. This violation may be enforced each 24 hours.

Section 28-392. - Parking violation notice; penalty.

Whenever any person is convicted of any act prohibited or declared to be unlawful by this division, shall be punished by a fine not less than \$250.0050.00 and not more than as provided by section 1-5 of this Code for each offense. This violation may be enforced each 24 hours.
