AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PEORIA PERTAINING TO BUILDING AND BUILDING REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the City Council is a home rule unit of government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois 1970, and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Chapter 5 of the Code of the City of Peoria is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken words and by adding the following underlined words:

Sec. 5-76. – Issuance; contents.

The code official shall within 20 days after an application has been filed by the owner or general contractor, issue a certificate of occupancy, if after inspection it is found that the building and site for which the certificate was requested substantially complied with the provisions of this chapter and all other requirements of law or ordinance applicable thereto. Such certificate of occupancy shall show the business name, the use group and type of construction, in accordance with the building code, the type of construction in accordance with the building code, and the zoning district and use in accordance with the unified development code. the name of the business, number of off-street parking spaces, and any special conditions of the building permit.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> This Ordinance shall be in effect 10 (ten) days after its passage and publication in pamphlet form.
