Daniel E. Stambaugh, Owner, Dan's Tow Bar, presented a Site Application to add a Class A (tavern) Liquor License at 1923 SW Adams.

In discussion with Chairman Cassidy, Mr. Stambaugh said the bar had a "tow theme" inside and he said he had cleaned up the establishment nicely. He reported that he owned two junk yards and several towing companies located within the surrounding area. He said he was not sure of the square footage of the bar, but he said the fire capacity was for forty-six people.

During more discussion, Mr. Stambaugh said there wasn't any onsite parking for the bar.

In response to a question from Commissioner O'Brien, Mr. Stambaugh said he planned to open the business as soon as his liquor license application was approved.

Deputy Corporation Counsel Sonni Williams pointed out the Community Development Department comments. She said she wanted to make sure the applicant knew that he needed to obtain all required building permits for any alterations to the site.

Hearing no more questions, Chairman Cassidy called for the motion.

Commissioner Miller moved to recommend approval of the Site Application for a Class A (tavern) Liquor License at 1923 SW Adams, contingent upon the successful compliance of all required building permits for alterations or expansions; seconded by Commissioner Coates.
