BACKGROUND: The Staffing and Adequate Fire and Emergency Response Grant (SAFER) was designed and implemented to help local and volunteer Fire Departments increase and/or maintain trained front-line firefighters. As of 9/21/2022, FEMA has announced 118 awards totaling \$360 million. The City of Peoria was awarded a grant of \$4,091,208.00 to help with the hiring of 11 new firefighters and fully staffing Engine 2.

The hiring of the 11 new recruits will bring total Suppression manpower to 171 men and women. This will allow for the full staffing of Engine 2 removing the need to for overtime.
