Dear Mr. Ardis,

Enclosed is an application from *Build Peoria* for a Class H temporary liquor license. This license will be used on Saturday, October 13, 2018 in the 1200 – 1300 blocks of SW Adams Street. Build Peoria is hosting their 1<sup>st</sup> annual *Big Picture Arts Festival*. The license will be used from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and allow for the sale and on-site consumption of alcoholic beverages. This event will consist of live music, children's art painting activities and food truck vendors will be on-site. Public Works will barricade this area along Adams Street from Spencer Street to MacArthur Highway. The music stage and beer truck will be located in a vacant lot on the southwest corner of Adams at MacArthur and secured with permanent fencing. Volunteers will be checking IDs and issuing wristbands in this designated area. Proceeds from this fundraiser will equally benefit Build Peoria and Big Picture Initiative, both of which are registered not-for-profit organizations with the Illinois Secretary of State.

Officer Kevin Slavens conducted a background check on the officers listed on the application. Mr. Nick A. Yates is the president and Ms. Andrea M. Huprich is the secretary of the organization. Ms. Eileen B. Leunig will be the event chairman. Nothing was found that would prevent these individuals or this organization from holding the requested temporary liquor license.

The Peoria Police Department has no objections to this temporary liquor license request.
