PUBLIC NOTICE

Governor JB Pritzker's Executive Order 2020-69, limits meetings to the lesser of 25 persons or 25% of the overall room capacity. Governor JB Pritzker's Executive Order 2020-07, as amended by Executive Order 2020-33, Executive Order 2020-44, and Executive Order-59 requires that public bodies take steps to provide video, audio, and/or telephonic access to meetings. The CDC recommends social distancing of at least six feet between persons. City Hall is currently closed to the public. To comply with these recommendations and requirements, the City is implementing the following changes and restrictions for the Special City Council Meeting on December 15, 2020 while complying with the spirit of the Open Meetings Act:
