ORDINANCE NO. 17,228

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PEORIA PERTAINING TO THE RENEWAL OF LICENSES OF STREET AND SIDEWALK VENDORS

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria, Illinois is a home rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Peoria, Illinois wishes to strengthen provisions for the reporting of sales and restaurant taxes owed to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Peoria, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. Section 18-520 is hereby amended by adding the following underlined words:

Sec. 18-520. - Application.

An application for a license required by this article shall be made in writing to the comptroller, which shall set forth the following:

- (1) The name of the individual applying for the license.
- (2) The residence, telephone number and driver's license number of the applicant.
- (3) The address of the principal place of business of the applicant and its telephone number.
- (4) If the applicant is employed by another person or entity, the name of the employer, its address and telephone number.
- (5) The type of goods, wares or merchandise to be sold or offered for sale.
- (6) The location where the applicant plans to sell his goods, wares or merchandise.
- (7) Whether the applicant has been convicted of a criminal offense or ordinance violation (other than traffic or parking offenses) in any jurisdiction and, if so, a list of such convictions with date and prosecuting jurisdiction.
- (8) For sites abutting property upon which there is located a structure which is occupied by a single business, a signed consent by the occupant that the same approves of the vendor being outside his business. For other sites, a signed consent by the owner of the property abutting the requested location that they approve of the vendor being outside his property.
- (9) When seeking a renewal, Downtown Business District Licensees must submit an accurate record of sales, organized by date, from the previous year. Upon request, the Licensee must produce documentation in a manner acceptable by the City sufficient to verify the record of sales, such as dated cash register records or numbered receipts. For 2016 renewals, these records should reflect sales made from June 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015.
