## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PEORIA PERTAINING TO LIQUOR LICENSE REGULATION

**WHEREAS**, the City of Peoria is a home rule unit of government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois 1970, and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs including regulating and licensing the retail sale and service of alcoholic liquors; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City of Peoria to amend Chapter 3 of the City of Peoria Code to add the definitions of "culinary education courses"; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City of Peoria to amend Chapter 3 of the City of Peoria Code to create the additional liquor license, "Class M-1" to establish a BYOB culinary education course license.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**Section 1:** Chapter 3 of the Code of the City of Peoria is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken words and by adding the following underlined words is as follows:

## Sec. 3-52 (14) – Classes

- (14) Class M. Class "M" licenses shall authorize an organization designated as a 501(c)(3) by the Internal Revenue Service to operate as a bottle club for on-site consumption only on premises approved by the mayor as being suitable and located within the River Entertainment District as defined in Ordinance No. 16864, as amended. For the purpose of catered or special events, Class M licensee shall not be prohibited from utilizing the catering services including retail sale of alcohol for on-site consumption served in conjunction with the service of a meal as authorized under the caterer's licensee. The hours of operation of a BYOB club under this license shall be limited from 4:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. in any one day and the annual fee for such license shall be \$125.00.
- (14.1) Class M-1. (BYOB Culinary Education Courses). Class "M-1" licenses shall authorize a private for profit business or organization engaged in the business of providing culinary education courses, to permit the on-site personal consumption of alcoholic liquor on the business premises. Class M-1 licensees shall not offer alcoholic liquor for sale or resale. The hours of operation of a BYOB culinary course licensee shall be from 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. in any one day and the annual fee for such license shall be \$400.00.
