The City of Peoria's Engineering Division will accept sealed submittals submitted to the Office of the City Engineer, Public Works Building, 3505 Drees Lane, Peoria, Illinois, 61604, until 4:00 p.m., Friday, March 11, 2016. For establishing contracts with qualified teams for various Phase I & Phase II, Phase III and Other technical services Work orders will be issued for individual projects under the blanket agreement and will be negotiated and authorized by the City Engineer or an as-needed basis.

The City plans to enter into a master professional services agreement with up to but not limited to eight (8) engineering firms for various services to the best-qualified teams. Each team will be considered and ranked by a Selection Committee based upon the criteria listed. The City will then enter into negotiations with the selected lead engineering firms to determine an upper limit master services agreement.
