AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 21 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PEORIA PERTAINING TO PARKS AND PUBLIC GROUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria, Illinois is a home rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Peoria, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. There shall be added to the Code of the City of Peoria the following underlined words and deleting the following stricken words in Article I of Chapter 21 of the Code of the City of Peoria pertaining to Parks and Public Grounds.

ARTICLE L - IN GENERAL

- Sec. 21-12. Reimbursements due city.
- (a) Services received from city. The sponsor of any festival, event, or parade on city-owned parks or public grounds shall within 30 days from the date of billing by the city, reimburse the city an amount determined by the city to be appropriate as the cost for services received from the city related to the event. Such services shall include, but not be limited to: site preparation and maintenance; site clean-up; traffic; crowd control and general security provided by the police department and/or ESDA; and fire safety services. The City will assess a fee of up to \$200.00 per police officer assigned to an event and \$100.00 per intersection that requires City barricades to close an intersection. The city will notify the event sponsor within 30 days of receipt of a fully completed event application of the estimated cost of such services, if known at that time.
 - (b) Damage to city property. The sponsor of any festival, event, or parade on city-owned parks or public grounds shall within 30 days from the date of billing by the city make arrangements with the comptroller or his designate to reimburse the city an amount determined by the city to be appropriate to compensate said city for any and all damage to city-owned property incurred as a result of the event.
