

Dear Mr. Reeise:

This letter will document the intent of the City of Peoria and the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) to enter into a binding agreement to transfer the City's rights to the property hereafter described.

The subject property is highlighted on the attached plat, and it is located inside the Department's access control limits for Interstate 74. During the preparation of the plat for the lease agreement, it was discovered that this area was still owned by the City of Peoria. The property is part of an old alley off Spalding Avenue, located between Madison and Monroe Streets. Part of the alley was vacated to the owners of what is now known as the Cornerstone Building many years ago, but there is another part of the alley that still belongs to the city.

As a part of our lease agreement with Conn Hospitality Group, part of IDOT's right of way is being used for their Obed and Isaac's Brewpub. The above referenced property is inside this area to be leased. To facilitate the lease process, IDOT is asking that the City of Peoria jurisdictionally transfer this right of way to the Department.

The Department agrees to prepare all plats and legal descriptions of the above-described property. The Department will also prepare the conveyance documents in accordance with 605 ILCS 5/4-508(d) and have them recorded in the Peoria County Recorder's office in Peoria, IL. The conveyance documents will include only property deemed to be necessary for highway use and not attendant excess property.

ARESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Conn Hospitality Group has developed the property at 321 NE Madison Avenue as Obed and Isaac's Brewpub:

WHEREAS, the Conn Hospitality Group requires a lease agreement on Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) owned property at the southeast corner of Spalding Avenue and Monroe Street for their use:

WHEREAS, a small parcel of a City-owned vacant alley is within the IDOT-owned property at the southeast comer of Spalding Avenue and Monroe Street;

WHEREAS, IDOT cannot execute the lease agreement with the Conn Hospitality Group, pursuant to its policies, until the City-owned portion of the property at the southeast corner of Spalding Avenue and Monroe Street is jurisdictionally transferred to IDOT:

WHEREAS, upon receipt of a Letter of Intent signed by the Public Works Director of the City of Peoria, IDOT will prepare the necessary plats and agreements to transfer the subject property by Jurisdictional Transfer from the City of Peoria to IDOT.

NOW, THEREFORE: BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Peoria, Illinois:

FIRST: That we do hereby authorize the Public Works Director to sign a Letter of Intent to transfer IDCT's property rights to the City of Peoria to accomplish the above.
