

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM ON THE
100 BLOCK OF WEST BEVERLY COURT.**

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted Division 7 of Article VII or Chapter 28 of the Peoria City Code, which authorized the establishment of a Residential Parking Permit Program (RPPP); and

Whereas, residents the 100 Block of West Beverly Court filed a petition containing at least 51 percent of the owners of parcels within the area described by the petition, per Sec. 28-411 of the City Code, for a RPPP in that area with the City; and

Whereas, the Transportation Commission (formerly Traffic Commission) held a public hearing on said petition and recommend that an RPPP be established in the area requested, per Sec. 28-415 of the City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A Residential Parking Permit Program (RPPP), as authorized by Article VII of Chapter 28 of the Peoria City Code, is hereby established for the following Designated Area:

100 Block West Beverly Court (North Linn Street east to the alley west of Knoxville Avenue).

SECTION 2. The terms and conditions of Article VII of Chapter 28 of the Peoria City Code shall apply to said RPPP.

SECTION 3. The parking restrictions for the RPPP established herein, in accordance with Sec. 28-413 of the Peoria City Code, are as follows:

Parking permits shall be required for the on-street parking of a vehicle in the Designated Area on Monday all days and all hours.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect 10 (ten) days after its passage and publication in pamphlet form.
