AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PEORIA RELATING TO THE ADVISORY COMMISSION ON HUMAN RESOURCES

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria is a home rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, as a home rule municipality, the City may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including citizens commissions; and

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria desires to amend Chapter 2, the Code of the City of Peoria;

NOW, AND THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> Chapter 2 of the Code of the City of Peoria, as adopted in 1957, is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken words and adding the following underlined words:

CHAPTER 2 – ADMINISTRATION

ARTICLE III - DEPARTMENTS

DIVISION 2. - HUMAN RESOURCES Reserved

Sec. 2-116. - Duties.

The department of human resources, under the supervision of the director of human resources, shall:

- (1) Supervise any social service programs budgeted for and provided by the city;
- (2) Coordinate with other public and private agencies the delivery of all social services within the city;
- (3) Prepare reports based upon research and study of the need for social services within the city and the funding of social service programs;
- (4) Provide the administrative services necessary to serve the advisory commission on human resources:
- (5) Provide advice and administrative assistance on other human relations problems to the city council and such commissions as may be requested by the council or the city manager;

- (6) Exercise such other powers germane to the powers granted herein as may be required by the city council; and
- (7) Assist private and public agencies in the city in obtaining funds from both public and private sources when it is determined that programs proposed by those agencies are needed and necessary for the well-being of the citizens of the city.

ARTICLE IV - ELECTED OFFICES, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES

DIVISION 5. - ADVISORY COMMISSION ON HUMAN RESOURCES CDBG PUBLIC SERVICES ADVISORY COMMISSION

Sec. 2-222. - Establishment; composition; appointment and terms of members; chairperson.

In order to accomplish the policy set forth in this division, there is hereby established a commission known as the advisory commission on human resources <u>CDBG Public Services Advisory Commission</u>, consisting of 13 members who are broadly representative of the religious, national, ethnic and economic groups in the city, to be appointed by the mayor with the advice and consent of the city council. The members of the <u>advisory commission on human resources CDBG Public Services Advisory Commission</u> shall serve for a term as set forth in section 2-162 of this Code. The commission shall choose its own chairperson.

Sec. 2-223. - Duties.

(a)The advisory commission on human resources CDBG Public Services Advisory Commission shall advise and consult with the city council, city officers and departments concerning the delivery of all social services available to the citizens of the city. The commission shall inventory and evaluate all social services provided by the social service agencies within the city. In addition, the commission shall aid in the coordination of the delivery in the social services provided by these agencies.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Ordinance shall be in full force immediately and upon passage and approval according to law.
