AGREEMENT

CITY OF PEORIA AND Bradley University

WHEREAS, Bradley desires to have decorative street name signs to improve the branding of their campus; and

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria desires to set forth the terms and conditions under which said decorative street name signs shall be installed;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises contained herein, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- Bradley submit the signs design the City for approval. The following criterial shall be followed for the signs to meet standards established in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD):
 - The height of lettering for the street name shall be 6" for upper case and 4-1/2" for lower case letters.
 - The prefix (N, S, etc.) shall be 4" in height.
 - The suffix (Pl, Rd, etc.) shall be 2-1/2" in height.
 - The hundred-block designation shall be 3" in height.
 - The signs will be of reflectorized (Illinois Department of Transportation Type A specifications for high intensity) face on flat blade type aluminum blank, 80 mil for 36" in length or less, 125 mil for greater than 36" in length.
- In the case that Bradley requests signs of a color not supported by the MUTCD (green, blue or brown), the City and Bradley understand that signs not supported by may be subject to replacement if required by the Federal government.
- Bradley shall submit proposed locations to the City for approval. Sign locations would typically replace existing City standard street name signs.

- Signs locations that are on mast arms must meet MUTCD standards, which would be of an approved color (the City prefers green) and have larger lettering requirements then listed in #1.
- 5. Requested locations along State routes will require state approval. The City will submit the permit request to the State for any signs that meet this criteria.
- 6. Bradley shall order and pay for the signs after design and locations are approved. The signs should be delivered to the City's Dries Lane facilities.
- 7. Bradley shall be responsible to pay to replace for lost, damaged or worn signs. If the damaged or worn signs are not replaced within thirty days the City will replace them with City standard signs.
- 8. The City will install the signs and perform routine maintenance on the signs. The City shall be responsible for all labor and costs associated with the removal of the existing signs and posts.
