BACKGROUND: Petitioner Joe Abraham, of Abraham and Son's Amusement, is requesting to rezone approximately 0.09 acres of land from a Class R-4 (Single Family Residential) to a Class CN (Neighborhood Commercial) District. The property is currently a vacant lot.

The Planning and Zoning Commission **VOTED 6 - 0 TO APPROVE** the rezoning request.
