**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Communication from the City Manager and Corporation Counsel to APPROVE the SITE APPLICATION for a CLASS H (Temporary Outdoor) Liquor License from the NEIGHBORHOOD HOUSE ASSOCIATION for an Event to be held at RUNNING CENTRAL, 311 SW WATER, On Saturday, May 16, 2015. (District 1)

**BACKGROUND:** The Neighborhood House Association has applied for a temporary outdoor liquor license that will allow for the sale and consumption of alcohol at an outdoor fundraiser during the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual George Jacob Gut Buster 5K Fun Run. The fundraiser will be held in a fenced off area on the sidewalk in front of Running Central between the hours of 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. Security will be provided by the Police Dept., employees and volunteers. All proceeds will benefit the Neighborhood House Association. The Peoria Police Department has recommended that this license be granted.
