Communication from the City Manager and Corporation Counsel with a Request to APPROVE the SITE APPLICATION for a Class B (restaurant, 50% food) Liquor License with On-Site Consumption and Retail Sale of Alcohol at OBED & ISAAC'S MICROBREWERY & EATERY, 321 NE MADISON, Contingent Upon the Issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy, with a Recommendation from the Liquor Commission to Approve. (Council District 1)

BACKGROUND: Court & Karen Conn, Owners, Conn's Hospitality Group, Inc., D/B/A Obed & Isaac's Microbrewery & Eatery, presented a Site Application for a Class B (restaurant, 50% food) Liquor License, with a Subclass 3 (beer garden) for 321 NE Madison.
