ACTION REQUESTED:

Communication from the City Manager and Director of Public Works with a Request to ADOPT an ORDINANCE VACATING 6,156 Square Feet (0.141 Acre) of an Alley Bounded by GREEN STREET, HANCOCK STREET, MADISON AVENUE and MONROE STREET, Adjacent to Lots 5 through 12, Block 35 of the ORIGINAL TOWN OF PEORIA, Peoria. (Council District 1)

BACKGROUND: The Catholic Diocese of Peoria (Diocese) has requested the vacation of 342.0 feet of the Alley adjacent to Lots 5 through 12 in Block 35 of the Original Town of Peoria. The Diocese and their entities own all the property in this block. The rights-of-way described are no longer of value to the public, and city staff has no objection to this vacation.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: None.

NEIGHBORHOOD CONCERNS: No known concerns.

IMPACT IF APPROVED: The Diocese will take ownership of the 342.0 feet of alley for its use and assume all future maintenance.

IMPACT IF DENIED: City will continue to maintain the alley and the Diocese will not be able to utilize the land.
