ACTION REQUESTED:

Communication from the City Manager and the Community Development Director with a Request to Concur with the Recommendation from the Planning and Zoning Commission and Staff to ADOPT an ORDINANCE Amending the OFFICIAL ZONING MAP of the City of Peoria to Rezone Property from a Class R-4 (Single Family Residential) to a Class CN (Neighborhood Commercial) District for the Property Located at 1904 W. GARDEN STREET (Parcel Identification No. 18-18-282-018), Peoria, Illinois. (Council District 1) BACKGROUND: Petitioner Joe Abraham, of Abraham and Son's Amusement, is requesting to rezone approximately 0.09 acres of land from a Class R-4 (Single Family Residential) to a Class CN (Neighborhood Commercial) District. The property is currently a vacant lot.

The Planning and Zoning Commission VOTED 6 - 0 TO APPROVE the rezoning request.
