Communication from the City Manager and Corporation Counsel to APPROVE the SITE APPLICATION for a CLASS H (Temporary Outdoor) Liquor License from the AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY for an Event to be Held at 5901 N. PROSPECT, on Thursday, September 21, 2017. (Council District 3)

BACKGROUND: The American Cancer Society has applied for a temporary outdoor liquor license that will allow for the sale and consumption of alcohol at a "Farm to Table Peoria" outdoor fundraiser.
