Communication from the City Manager and Corporation Counsel with a Request to APPROVE the SITE APPLICATION for a Class B (Restaurant, 50% Food) Liquor License with On-Site Consumption and Retail Sale of Alcohol at INDIAN TADKA PEORIA, LLC, D/B/A INDIAN TADKA RESTAURANT, 7815 N. KNOXVILLE, SUITE 12, Contingent Upon Issuance of all Appropriate Permits and a Certificate of Occupancy, with a Recommendation from the Liquor Commission to Approve. (Council District 5)
