Communication from the City Manager and Corporation Counsel with a Request to APPROVE the SITE APPLICATION for a Class C-1 (Packaged Goods) Liquor License with the Retail Sale of Alcohol at GB LICENSE, LLC, D/B/A GOPUFF at 3455 N. UNIVERSITY STREET, With a Stipulation of NO Walk-In/On-Premise Sales and All Sales will be Delivery-Based Only, and Contingent Upon Issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy, with a Recommendation from the Liquor Commission to Approve.
