**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Communication from the City Manager and Community Development Director with a Request to ADOPT an ORDINANCE Amending the DEFINITION of TIRE BUSINESSES in CHAPTER 18 of the CODE of the City of Peoria.

**BACKGROUND:** On August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021, the City Council adopted an ordinance requiring "Tire Businesses" in the City of Peoria to obtain an annual license to help combat illegal dumping. At the August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021 City Council Meeting, Councilman John Kelly asked for language to be added to the ordinance to clarify that the license applies not only to businesses with a physical address in the City of Peoria, but also for tire businesses who do work within the City of Peoria limits related to the ordinance regardless of their physical location.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:** NA

**NEIGHBORHOOD CONCERNS:** Better regulation of tire businesses will help with illegal dumping concerns in our neighborhoods.
